The Jimmy Carter Library & Museum and the Coca-Cola Foundation have generously established funding for the Carter Library to provide transportation funds for Georgia schools to use when bringing students to our newly-renovated museum for educational activities.

After undergoing a ten-million dollar renovation in 2009, our Museum is now one of the most high-tech, energy and environment-friendly museums in the country. Come and visit an exact replica of the Carter oval office, spend A Day In the Life of a President, conduct interactive Virtual Research in our stacks, or learn about the post-presidency work of the Carter Center.

Sponsorships are available to all schools within the state of Georgia,¹ and you may submit applications year-round! The sponsorship will cover all student museum admission fees as well as your school's transportation costs.²

If you wish to participate in this program, you must submit a written estimate of the transportation expense on your Application Form in advance. Use of charter buses must be approved in advance by Jimmy Carter Library & Museum staff*. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in a decision not to pay your transportation expenses.

You must complete and submit a written application for your request to be considered. Applications will be considered in the order they are received.
