Spring Comes to The Presidential Park on Freedom Parkway

Carter Presidential Center Offers Beautiful Escape

ATLANTA, GA. - The flowers are blooming, the trees are budding. Ducks swim in the lakes. Spring has come to the Carter Presidential Center.

The Carter Presidential Center is located on a 35 acre landscaped park with two small lakes, a serene Japanese Garden designed by Master Gardener Kinsaku Nakane, a Rose Garden with more than 40 varieties of roses, a cherry tree orchard and a native oak forest.

Bradford pear trees are currently blooming and the apple blossoms are out. Tulips are coming up and the white and pink azaleas are filling the front lawn of the Carter Center with color.

The Presidential Park on Freedom Parkway is open to the public. Whether for a morning stroll, lunch by the lake at the Copenhill Cafe or brown bag it on one of the picnic tables, the Carter Presidential Center offers a quiet place to relax and reflect. There are walking paths along the lakes, and benches to sit and view the Atlanta skyline. Bring a blanket and a book and lay on the lush green lawn.

Located just minutes from downtown Atlanta and with plenty of free parking, The Presidential Park on the Parkway is a hidden gem for Atlantans.
