### MEET BEST-SELLING AUTHORS AT CARTER LIBRARY

*FREE READINGS AND BOOK SIGNINGS THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER*

**Atlanta, GA.-** The Jimmy Carter Presidential Library hosts free monthly talks by some of the nation's best authors. From the *New York Times Book Reviews* #1 best-selling biographer Walter Isaacson (*Einstein: His Life and Universe*) to Public Radio's *Speaking of Faith* host Krista Tippett, the list of Carter Library speakers is a literary who's who.

Speakers have included Pulitzer Prize winners & finalists (Natasha Trethewey, Hank Klibanoff, Leonard Pitts Jr., Taylor Branch and E.L. Doctorow), historian and Presidential Medal of Freedom winner John Hope Franklin, environmentalist Paul Hawken, as well as commentators Al Franken and Sarah Vowell.

President and Mrs. Carter, former Vice President Walter Mondale, former Secretary of State Madeline Albright and former Senator John Edwards also have been among the speakers at these free lectures.

Upcoming authors include former White House correspondent Lynne Olson speaking about her new, highly-praised book "*Troublesome Young Men: The Rebels who Brought Churchill to Power and Saved England*" and Catherine Lewis, author of "*Don't Ask What I Shot: How Eisenhower's Love of Golf Helped Shape 1950's America.*"

Lynne Olson will speak and sign copies of her book at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 5<sup>th</sup> at the Carter Library; Catherine Lewis comes to the Carter Library on Tuesday, July 10<sup>th</sup>. Doors open at 6:30 p.m. No reservations are needed. Seating is first-come/first seated.
