LUNCHTIME CONCERTS AT THE CARTER PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY *CHOIR AND CHAMBER ENSEMBLE TO PERFORM*

Atlanta, GA.- The beautiful sounds of a youth choir and a chamber ensemble will fill the Jimmy Carter Presidential Library lobby for lunchtime concerts in June and July.

At 11:30 a.m. on Tuesday, June 19th, the youth choir from the Church of the Saviour United Methodist in Cincinnati, Ohio will sing songs of peace. Each summer, the choir travels across the country entertaining groups and building friendships. The concert will last about a half hour and is open to the public at no charge.

In July, members of the Franklin Pond Chamber Ensemble will perform in the Carter Library lobby. The four-piece ensemble includes two violins, one viola and one cello. The Franklin Pond Chamber Music program began in 2002 as a means of providing young musicians with training in the fine art of chamber music. The program allows students to interact with highly qualified professionals and offers training with faculty members and guest artists.

The Franklin Pond Chamber Ensemble will perform at noon on Tuesday, July 17th. The 45 minute concert is free and open to the public.
