CARTER LIBRARY CELEBRATES VETERANS DAY WEEKEND

FREE ADMISSION TO VETERANS ON NOV. 11 & 12

PRES. VICENTE FOX TO SPEAK ON NOV. 12

Atlanta, GA.- In commemoration of Veterans' Day, the Jimmy Carter Presidential Library and Museum invites veterans to visit the Carter Presidential Museum free of charge on Sunday, November 11th and Monday, Nov. 12th. The normal admission charge will be waived to those who have served in the military.

Step into an exact replica of the Oval Office; see the actual gold Nobel Peace Prize awarded to President Carter; look at exquisite State Gifts and learn about President Carter's service to the country during his military and political careers. In addition, see an inspiring exhibit "Beyond the Presidency" which describes the work President and Mrs. Carter have done over the past 25 years at the Carter Center.

Also on Monday, November 12th, join the Carter Library and the Georgia Center for the Book for a special evening with the former President of Mexico, Vicente Fox. President Fox will discuss his new book "Revolution of Hope" and sign copies of the book during an evening not to be missed.

President Fox's reading and book signing is free and open to the public. Doors open at 6 pm and the lecture begins at 7 pm. Copies of "Revolution of Hope" will be for sale at the event. The book signing will follow the lecture.
