**Atlanta, GA.-** Don't miss seeing "Beyond the Presidency: 25 Years of the Carter Center." This fascinating look at the work President and Mrs. Carter have done through the Carter Center ends Sunday, November 25<sup>th</sup>.

Friday, November 23<sup>rd</sup> is the perfect time to see not only the "Beyond the Presidency" exhibit, but also to hear members of the Southern Order of Storytellers recount "A Fork in the Road-Choices in History."
