Former New York Times Washington correspondent Clymer discusses his new book "Drawing the Line at the Big Ditch, The Panama Canal Treaties and the Rise of the Right." CSPAN will be recording the lecture for presentation on Book TV. Free and open to the public

Tuesday, April 15th ... 7:00 p.m. Richard Cohen in the Carter Center's Cecil B. Day Chapel

Cohen's new book "Strong at the Broken Places" tells the remarkable story of five ordinary people trapped in the complex world of serious chronic illness. In this intimate portrait, Cohen probes lives of sickness as these individuals struggle to cope. Free and open to the public.
