## KEVIN PHILLIPS & PRESIDENT CARTER HOLD BOOK SIGNINGS

*JOIN PHILLIPS ON TUESDAY & PRES. CARTER ON WEDNESDAY*

**ATLANTA, GA.** - The Carter Presidential Library and the Georgia Center for the Book are proud to host author Kevin Phillips, discussing his new book *Bad Money. Reckless Finance, Failed Politics, and the Global Crisis of American Capitalism* on Tuesday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00 p.m.

In “Bad Money,” Phillips describes what he sees as the consequences of misguided economic policies, mounting debt, collapsing housing market, threatened oil, and the end of American domination of world markets. Following the reading, Phillips will sign copies of his book.

The following day, Wednesday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>, President Jimmy Carter will be at the Carter Presidential Library to sign copies of his new memoir about his mother, “Miss Lillian.” The book signing begins at 5:30 p.m. in the Museum lobby. To allow the President to sign as many books as possible, He will **ONLY SIGN BOOKS** he has written. He will not personalize books. He will not pose for photos. The President will sign up to **five books per person**, per trip through the line. You can go through the line again. Each group of books to be signed **must include** at least one copy of “A Remarkable Mother.”
