Tennessee Students Coming to Atlanta for Chance to See Pres. Carter *Field Trip to See Carter Library and Meet the Former President*

Atlanta, GA. - More than forty students from Bradley Central High School in Cleveland, Tennessee are coming to Atlanta next week on a very special field trip. The eleventh and twelfth graders are coming to see the Carter Presidential Museum and they have timed their trip so they can meet the former President himself.

“This is an opportunity that they will remember for their entire lives,” said teacher Andy McMahan. “This is something they will tell their grandchildren about. My hope is that this trip will further spark an interest in both history and politics.”

The students will tour the Carter Presidential Museum on Wednesday afternoon, January 21st and then attend President Carter’s book signing at the Carter Library. President Carter will be signing copies of his new book “We Can Have Peace in the Holy Land” (to be released Tuesday, January 20th).

McMahan brought a different group of students to President Carter’s book signing in October, 2007. “I still have conversations with those former students about the trip.” McMahan said. “I was in the grocery store a few weeks ago and got introduced to a parent from a former student as “the teacher who took me to meet President Carter.”
