Pat Conroy Reading Sold Out *More Authors Coming to Carter Library*

Atlanta, GA. - The response to the Pat Conroy reading has been overwhelming. All of the tickets to tomorrow night's (Aug. 19th) reading have been sold. There will be no tickets available at the door and because of safety restrictions, there is no standing room. Pat Conroy's reading will be held at the Carter Center's Cecil B. Day Chapel. Doors open at 6 p.m. and Conroy's talk with Atlanta magazine writer Teresa Weaver and his wife and author Cassandra King begins at 7 p.m. Because each of the paid tickets includes a pre-signed copy of *South of Broad*, there will be no signing following the reading.

Following Conroy's talk with Ms. King and Ms. Weaver, he will answer written questions from the audience. Carter Center staff members will have cards and pencils available.
