Lunchtime Concert at Carter Presidential Museum

Atlanta, GA. - Stop by the Jimmy Carter Presidential Museum for a special lunchtime concert by the Wilshire Baptist Church Youth Choir at noon on Wednesday, June 22nd. The half-hour concert will be in the lobby of the Carter Presidential Museum and is free.

This 60-voice choir of seventh- through 12th-graders from Dallas, Texas will sing a diverse repertoire of sacred and secular music, mixing classical with gospel and pop.

Their concert at the Carter Museum is part of the choir's annual summer concert and mission tour. While in Atlanta, the choir also will engage in a variety of hands-on service projects in partnership with local agencies who serve those in need. In recent past summers, the choir has traveled to Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic (the choir's first international trip), Memphis, Boston, New Orleans, Chicago and Albuquerque.

Wilshire's Youth Choir is directed by Doug Haney, a veteran conductor of youth choruses in four states. Wilshire Baptist Church is a congregation of about 2,500 members located in Northeast Dallas, Texas.
