Heather Pars Campion was born May 26, 1947 in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Campion graduated cum laude from Mount Holyoke College. She first served as an intern in the Carter White House from January 1978 to June 1978 in the Speechwriting Office, where she worked for James Fallows. She then continued her work in the Carter White House as a staff member in the Office of Public Liaison working for Anne Wexler from August 1979 to January 1981. She held numerous positions at Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government, helping to build the School's Center for Business and Government, and serving as director of the Public Liaison office from 1981-1988. She was director of the John F. Kennedy Jr. Forum, and associate director of the Institute of Politics from 1990-1998.
