Scope and Content:

The collection contains correspondence, lists, memoranda, resumes, reports, publications, and press releases compiled by staff of the Presidential Personnel Office (PPO). The materials include information on individuals whose positions were subject to presidential appointment, such as those on commissions, boards, committees, councils, agencies, and other organizations.

The material covers the steps involved in the appointment process, including:

- the search for potential appointees;
- the screening process used to evaluate candidates and solicit opinions;
- the processing of clearances, such as security and conflict of interest;
- preliminary and final recommendations;
- the appointment itself; and
- resignations and subsequent replacement appointments.

Creator Information:

The Presidential Personnel Office was responsible for presidential appointments. It reviewed candidates, conducted interviews, evaluated recommendations from members of Congress and other interested parties, communicated with departments and agencies on personnel matters, and helped ensure that the personnel priorities of the Carter administration were being addressed. (It should not be confused with the White House Personnel Office, which managed career White House employees and detailees

from other government agencies and provided personnel support for the White House staff.) It was headed by a director, and other staff included a deputy director, assistants, and staffing specialists.

Restrictions on Access: Some materials are restricted due to privacy or security concerns. Researchers may contact the Library for information about how to appeal the access restriction decision for individual documents.

Detailed Description of the Collection

Job Files

Scope and Content: Containers 1-64. This series opened in December 2017. The series consists of correspondence from members of Congress, copies of presidential appointment letters, lists of candidates and appointees, resumes, recommendations, remarks, interview evaluations, resignation letters, memoranda, reports, publications, and press releases. The Presidential Personnel Office maintained these files to collect materials related to the staffing of commissions, boards, committees, councils, agencies, and other organizations composed of individuals whose positions were subject to presidential appointment. Among the recommendations are numerous notes and letters from members of Congress regarding positions sought by constituents. The selection and appointment process are evident from the files, and there are many examples of efforts to create a diverse and inclusive administration. Arranged alphabetically by acronyms.

Sharon Green's Personnel Files

Scope and Content: Container 65-67. This series opened in April 2019. The series consists of material concerning individuals under consideration for employment with various agencies, commissions, committees, and boards on the White House staff during the Carter Administration. This series mainly contains job applications, biographical information, resumes, case referral sheets, memorandums, recommendations and correspondence. Arranged alphabetically by last name.

Rick Hernandez's Subject Files

Scope and Content: Container 68-74. This series opened in June, 2019. The series consist of memoranda, correspondence, newspaper clippings, press releases, reports and printed material. The material highlights subjects of vital interest to Hispanics as well as Puerto-Rican Affairs during the Carter administration. The material is related to Hernandez's role as Deputy Assistance to the President. In addition, the files include information on the National Economic Development Association (NEDA), the National Coalition of Hispanic Mental Health and Human Services (COSSMHO), Mexican American Legal Defense and Educational Fund (MALDEF), and the La Raza Alliance. Arranged alphabetically by subject.

Diana Rock's Subject Files

Scope and Content: Containers 75-94. This series opened in September, 2019. The series consist of correspondence, memorandum, newspaper clippings, biographical data sheets, resumes, briefing books, press releases, and telephone logs. Also included are recommendations, presidential appointments, position descriptions for various departments, and a directory of members of Congress. The files relate to Diana Rock's position as Associate Director of the Presidential Personnel Office. Arranged alphabetically by folder title.
