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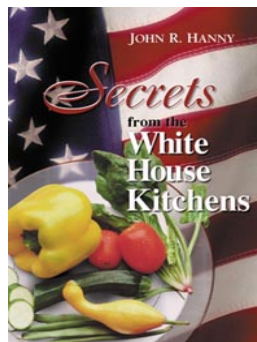
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Secrets from the White House Kitchens Revealed at Carter Library ***John R. Hanny Gives Recipes and Discusses Foods Favored by First Families***

For example, the Roosevelts favored dishes rich in cream, while Jackie Kennedy brought worldly sophistication to State Dinners. Southern style was favored by the Johnsons and the Carters, while the Clintons raised eyebrows by hiring a chef specializing in light cuisine.

In addition to his essays on the foods favored by various administrations, Hanny provides easy to follow recipes that will enable readers to treat their friends and family to dishes that would tempt a world leader.
