Al Franken Signed Books

"The Truth" with Signed Bookplates Available to Those Who Couldn't Attend Lecture

Atlanta, GA. - Author and political commentator Al Franken attracted such a large audience when he spoke at the Jimmy Carter Presidential Library and Museum last month that many people were unable to attend the lecture or purchase a signed copy of Franken's book "The Truth (with Jokes)".

"We could accommodate about 500 visitors in our auditorium, but we had many more who wanted to attend the lecture," Carter Library spokesman Tony Clark said. "Franken felt badly that everyone who wanted to attend the lecture couldn't get in or get a book signed."

Before he left for his USO tour, Franken signed bookplates to enable those who could not get a seat at the Carter Library to be able to purchase an autographed book.
