LAST CHANCE TO SEE CARTER PRESIDENTIAL MUSEUM & LINCOLN EXHIBIT *FINAL DAY IS THIS SUNDAY (APRIL 26TH)*

Atlanta, GA.- This is your last weekend, in fact, your last days, to see the Jimmy Carter Presidential Museum before it closes for a five-month, \$10 million redesign. Walk along the Wall of Presidents; see the Nobel Peace Prize; step into an exact replica of the Oval Office and see documents and artifacts that describe the life and career of the 39th President.

We're changing almost everything in the new museum, so this is your last chance to see it with the way it was first designed. There are exquisite State Gifts on display and exhibits on the issues that were the forefront of the Carter Administration.

This also is your last chance to see *Lincoln: The Constitution and the Civil War*. This fascinating Exhibition shows the 16th President in a way you may never have imagined. The National Constitution Center created this exhibit and the Carter Library is proud to present it as we celebrate the 200th anniversary of Lincoln's birth.
