The Thanksgiving holiday is a wonderful time to visit the all new Carter Presidential Museum. The museum was completely redesigned this year. It is bright, colorful and full of videos and interactive exhibits the whole family will enjoy.

Also, don't miss the opportunity to meet former First Lady Rosalynn Carter at the Carter Presidential Library, on Thursday, December 2nd at 7 pm. Mrs. Carter will discuss her book ***Within Our Reach: Ending the Mental Health Crisis***. A book signing will follow the discussion. No reservations are required, but seating is limited. Doors to the Carter Presidential Museum Theater will open at 6 pm; the discussion begins at 7:00pm and will be followed by a book signing. ACappella Books will have copies of ***Within Our Reach*** available for purchase at the reading.

Mrs. Carter will only be signing ***Within Our Reach*** or other BOOKS she has written. She will personalize books, but in order to get to everyone, she will not be able to pose for photographs or sign items other than her BOOKS.

We have another special treat on Tuesday, December 7th at 7 pm in the Carter Center's Day Chapel. NPR host Michele Norris will discuss her new book, ***The Grace of Silence*** with WABE's Valerie Jackson. The program will be recorded for Jackson's ***Between the Lines***. No reservations are needed, but seating is limited. Following the program, Norris will be signing copies of her book.
