While we continue to dearly miss hosting student and teacher groups in our museum, the Carter Library will continue to remotely engage our

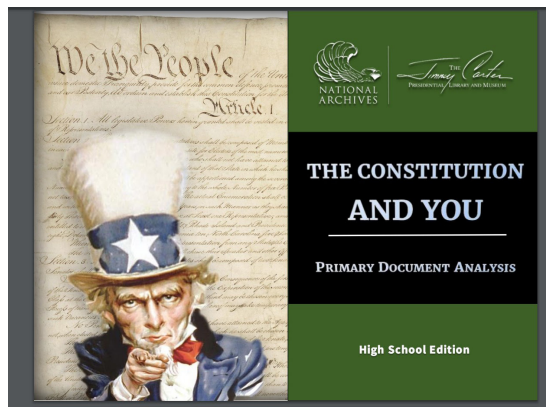

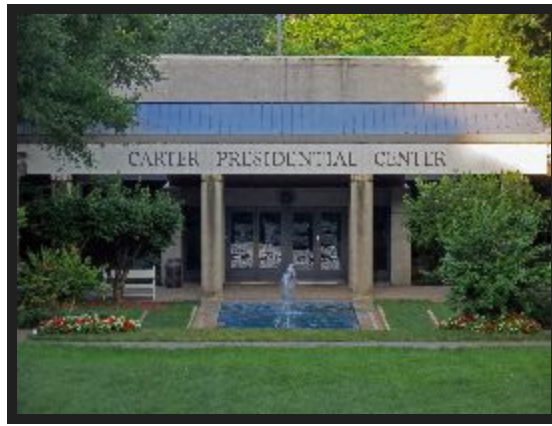
Senior Community Distance Learning
