Consequently efficient use of the system depends upon keeping up with the changes which our Indexing and Technical staffs will be implementing in the weeks and months to come.

Thesaurus terms are, of course, the most rapidly growing part of the system. For the best results in searching The Bank's resources you should regularly scan the more important generic term additions. You can do this quickly and easily on-line by keying in *New Search Terms* at the Term Entry stage on your terminal. The system will respond to this command with a review of recent postings to the Thesaurus. Here is a sampling of the more important listings that have come on-line in the past few months:

ACCOUNTING AND ACCOUNTANTS

— This new term should be distinguished from *Accounting and Accountants (General)*. It should be used in conjunction with specific companies, industries, products, commodities, etc. It is good for getting to specific instances of accounting procedures in action.

ACCOUNTING AND ACCOUNTANTS (GENERAL)

— As distinguished from *Accounting and Accountants*, this term should be used to obtain material on general accounting practices and principles. For example, it is useful for retrieving articles on recent revisions to federal accounting regulations.

BALANCE OF PAYMENTS

— To be used for material on individual countries and more global economic policies.

CONSUMER BEHAVIOR

— For opinions on new trends and products.

LABOR ROLE IN MANAGEMENT

— For material on workers' impact on wage and benefit negotiations and employees' participation in the management decisions of their Company.

BUSINESS ROLE IN POLITICS

— For material on how various industries and companies influence governmental decisions; especially useful for getting information on the pressures brought to bear on regulatory agencies by lobbyists, economic trends, and rates of employment growth.

— For information on either specific companies or countries.

DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

— For articles dealing with either decisions to reveal previously classified information or instances of public, private, or legal pressure upon government or business to make currently withheld information generally available.

THIRD WORLD AND DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

— A broad term dealing with conditions and policies in the third world as a whole along with the events which affect them.

COMPANY REPORTS

— Should be used for obtaining information concerning financial reports issued by corporations, labor unions, foundations and similar institutions. This is a useful term for getting at specific data on sales, earnings, operating costs, and other financial figures. It should be distinguished from the term *Company Profiles*.

COMPANY PROFILES

— This term, as distinguished from *Company Reports*, will provide access to data which is less statistical and more interpretive. It is useful for determining the nature of a company's activities, organizational make-up, and personal style.

I will be covering the range of search terms and how best to use them in upcoming issues. If you have suggestions for term additions, please send them to us with an explanation of their utility to your search requirements. Your feedback can help us tailor our service to your needs.

The New Information Bank

The new masthead at the top of this issue of *inforum* signals a number of important changes recently instituted at The Information Bank. Our name and address for instance: we are now officially The Information Bank, a subsidiary of The New York Times Company residing in Parsippany, New Jersey, rather than The New York Times Information Bank operating from The Times' offices in Manhattan.

Under the direction of The Bank's President Carl Keil, Vice President Gordon H. Runner and Managing Editor James Bauer, we have relocated our headquarters to Mount Pleasant Office Park, 1719A Route 10, Parsippany, New Jersey 07054, where we have reorganized our system operations and established our new national marketing office. This new facility has become the pulse of The Information Bank. Whether by leased line or dial-up terminal, you are now accessing The Bank's extensive retrieval resources at our Parsippany site. This restructuring of our operations has an important bearing on our current and future services to you.

WHAT'S IN A NAME AND ADDRESS

What does this relocation mean to you, our subscribers? Well, it means much more than a routine change of mailing address and phone number. Our new location and new organizational status have brought with them some important enhancements to our service. Our new hardware configuration and strategic software modifications have prepared us to meet the increased demands of both the present and the future. Let's briefly look at the changes being put into effect right now.

• Improved Technical and Editorial Operations:

We have equipped our New Jersey headquarters with two distinct computer systems. One system processes the data capturing performed by our indexing staff while the other provides the on-line data retrieval powers you access daily. This separation of the data capturing from the data retrieval functions affords us the kind of flexibility necessary to exact greater quality control over the indexing and editing procedures while insuring fast, efficient information retrieval for you. Together with this new system configuration, we have also restructured our work force so as to bring together our technical, editorial, marketing, and administrative staffs in a way that enables us to further accelerate the procedures by which we process, validate and place information on-line for your retrieval purposes.

non-Times material. This overall enlargement of the in-house indexing staff is yet another way in which we are improving the quality of our service while providing you with an accelerated information update.

● **Private Communication Networks:** Beginning this year we have been offering our Washington, D. C. area and West Coast subscribers the option of dialing into The Bank's system across our private communications networks. This means that a subscriber in San Francisco or Washington, D. C. can now dial into The Bank on a local telephone number while subscribers in the surrounding areas can reach our system through shorter and less expensive long distance telephone service. Within the next few months we will bring up a similar network in Chicago. As we expand our services, we will be adding more of these private networks in order to accommodate our subscribers with the saving and convenience of accessing our system through local or short distance telephone calls.

● **Branch Marketing Offices:** Our New York marketing office recently opened its new quarters at One World Trade Center in Manhattan while our Washington, D. C. branch celebrated its first anniversary at 1909 K Street. In the planning are new branch offices in San Francisco and Chicago. Like our already established branches, these new offices will be staffed with teams of highly trained representatives ready to provide professional support throughout the extent of our system's growing reach. We specialize in service and mean to be there to meet the increased demands of our rapidly expanding subscriber base.

WHAT'S ON LINE?

Having briefly considered The Bank's current and projected innovations, let's take a closer look at our present status.

To date there are over 1,162,000 abstracts in our data base. This number increases by 20,000 abstracts per month; that's 1000 abstracts per working day. With all of this resource material stored and held in its data base, The Information Bank becomes daily a more powerful reference tool as its retrospective dimension deepens and its currency rate rises.


But more than putting these vast amounts of information on-line, our editors and indexers are continually engaged in refining the methods by which all this material can be retrieved in useful components. They periodically evaluate the thesaurus of terms used to search the system, making qualifications and additions wherever necessary. Since January, 176 new generic search terms have been added to the system's thesaurus. These terms, together with those already established in the data base, have been decided upon with care. They are the keys with which you can unlock from the system only that information which is relevant to your particular needs.

TECHNICALLY SPEAKING

One of the largest data bases commercially available, The Information Bank is also the only one to offer such a variety of both general and specialized sources. And now that we have relocated, we have been able to step up the pace at which our system develops its resources and powers of re-

trieval, which means more journals, more special features, more diversity — in short, a system more responsive to your information needs. All this has been made possible by fundamental changes in our hard and software configurations. Without going into an overly detailed analysis of the technical refinements which have been implemented at our new headquarters, we would like briefly to outline their impact upon The Bank's operations because, both directly and indirectly, these altered operations affect your use of The Bank's system.

The technical advancements already implemented make ours a much more flexible and much more readily refineable system than had existed previously. For instance, as mentioned earlier, we have divorced our data capturing procedures from our on-line retrieval system. This means that all the steps involved in composing, indexing, and editing abstracts are now performed on-line through a mini-computer distinct from but operationally integrated with our main-frame computer's retrieval powers. Consequently, the abstracting process can be managed more closely and efficiently while our retrieval system can respond to your commands with a significantly faster response time than before.

DATA ENTRY

Previously data capturing involved a series of discrete steps which took two to five days to complete. Our indexers were operating within the constraints imposed by the necessity of processing data entry on the same system responsible for responding to retrieval commands. The validation of search terms and editing of abstracts had to be performed in separate phases each of which had to be scheduled after the system's retrieval functions had ceased for the day. The introduction of The Bank's mini-computer has removed many of these time consuming limitations.

Because it operates independently of the main-frame system, we have been able to program the mini-computer so that it performs an interactive syntax check simultaneous with data entry. This means that search terms and bibliographic codes are validated as our indexers key the information into a terminal on-line with our mini-computer. Once an abstract is composed and indexed with the appropriate search terms, it is then automatically routed via terminal to one of six editors who verifies and corrects it also on-line.

From here, the indexed, edited abstract is processed by our mini-computer for data entry on our main-frame system.

According to Managing Editor, James Bauer, "This data capturing system now gives us the ability to process abstracts

within one working day." What does this mean for you? Simply this: information we abstract from a journal today, you can retrieve tomorrow. In fact, our overall processing time has been so significantly reduced that by the end of 1976 The New York Times and other key journals will be abstracted and placed on-line for retrieval within forty-eight hours of publication. We also plan to establish data entry schedules which will place other, highly topical journals on-line within seven to fourteen days of publication. No other commercial data base approaches this rate of currency.

DATA RETRIEVAL

By dividing data processing tasks between our two computer systems, we not only achieve quicker, more accurate indexing, but also provide for increased capabilities within our main-frame computer. Freed from the operations entailed in processing the multi-staged data entry procedures and invested with a memory one and a half times as large as that which had existed in our previous system, our new main-frame computer has more room for the addition of specially programmed features like the daily News Summary which appears on-line each morning by 9:00 A. M., E. S. T. or E. D. T., and the continuous on-line update of new search terms as they are added to the system's thesaurus.

More immediately you probably have already noticed the speed with which the computer responds to your commands as you move from one step to the next in your searches. This faster response time is yet another advantage of our larger and more efficient system.

The Bank's new speed and flexibility are only the beginning of what we envision will be an extensive streamlining of our increasingly diversified service.

SYSTEM MONITOR: COMMUNICATIONS

If at any time the system seems unwilling to answer you, don't give up on it. Call the System Monitor. More often than not the obstacle to effective communication between your terminal and our computer can be readily resolved over the phone. George McCartney, the man in charge of monitoring the system at our new headquarters, usually can identify communications problems by means of a few simple diagnostic tests. Once he has located where the difficulty resides, he can determine what steps must be taken to correct it. Often this means making a few simple re-adjustments either at your terminal or on our equipment. If the problem is not in the equipment at either end but rather somewhere

in the telephone lines between us, the System Monitor can arrange to re-route your data call in order to bypass the line interference and bring you successfully into the system. At other times, the Monitor may determine that difficulty accessing the system has the symptoms of a problem requiring repair. In this case, he will alert you to the appropriate service.

When you do have to make a trouble call to the Monitor, it is very important — if at all possible — that you use a phone other than the one with which you access the system. This will give you and the Monitor the chance to run through some practical diagnostics. He will be able to monitor what happens as you dial into the system on your data phone while advising you on the other phone. Under these conditions, he frequently will be able to notify you of the problem's nature and method of resolution within moments. On the other hand, if you call him with your data phone, he will have no way to diagnose your difficulty directly. He will only be able to provide you with some general hypotheses as to what the problem is and how it might be solved.

SYSTEM MONITOR: SEARCH STRATEGIES

"I want articles covering the hard-hat anti-anti-war demonstration which took place on Wall Street sometime around 1969 or 1970."

"What can the system tell me about the state of the world food crisis since 1974?"

"I need to locate material which covers recent discussions of plans for a projected federation of European nations. This has nothing to do with the European Common Market."

These are a sampling of search problems the System Monitor has helped solve recently. If you find yourself stymied in the
