SUBJECT: RADIOACTIVE WASTE PROBLEM

THE ATTACHED STATEMENT CONCERNS A STUDY PREPARED FOR THE ENERGY RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION. ACCORDING TO A NYT ARTICLE TODAY (P. 17), THE RADIOACTIVE WASTE PROBLEM IS A SERIOUS ONE AND POSES MAJOR HEALTH HAZARDS. THIS STATEMENT COULD BE USED IN CONNECTION WITH THE STATEMENT KITTY SCHIRMER SENT TO YOU RECENTLY ON TAIWAN FUEL REPROCESSING.

YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF A POSSIBLE FOLLOW-UP QUESTION RELATING BACK TO YOUR STATEMENT THAT YOU WOULD PROBABLY HAVE SUPPORTED THE NUCLEAR SAFEGUARDS INITIATIVE IN OREGON. THAT MEASURE WOULD HAVE REQUIRED AS A CONDITION OF STATE PERMISSION TO OPERATE A PLANT THAT THE OWNER HAVE EITHER A FACILITY OR A DEMONSTRABLE PLAN TO DISPOSE OF NUCLEAR WASTE. AN ALERT REPORTER COULD ASK WHETHER THIS MEANS THAT YOU WOULD SUSPEND ALL NEW REACTOR LICENSING AT THE FEDERAL LEVEL UNTIL A MEANS OF STORING OR DISPOSING OF RADIOACTIVE WASTE IS DEVELOPED. SINCE IT IS UNLIKELY THAT WE CAN HAVE A PERMANENT STORAGE FACILITY IN OPERATION BEFORE THE EARLY 1980'S, THE WASTE QUESTION COULD POSE THE QUESTION OF A SEVERAL YEAR MORATORIUM ON NEW

REACTOR SITING AND CONSTRUCTION. THE BEST RESPONSE IS THAT WE SHOULD NOT BRING NEW REACTORS ON LINE UNLESS WE HAVE ADEQUATE TEMPORARY STORAGE FACILITIES AND ARE PRESSING FOR A LONG-TERM ANSWER.

STATEMENT ON RADIOACTIVE WASTE PROBLEM

ONE OF THE MOST SERIOUS SAFETY QUESTIONS RELATING TO NUCLEAR POWER --THE RADIOACTIVE WASTE PROBLEM--HAS REARED ITS HEAD IN A RECENT REPORT PREPARED FOR THE ENERGY RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION.

THIS PROBLEM IS NOT A 1984 DELUSION. IT IS A SERIOUS AND IMMEDIATE THREAT THAT REQUIRES A FIRM GOVERNMENTAL RESPONSE. NOT ONLY MUST THE NUCLEAR WASTE PROBLEM BE ADDRESSED ON A CRASH BASIS, IT REQUIRES A SPECIFIC CHANGE IN OUR CURRENT NATIONAL ENERGY POLICY, MINIMIZING AT LEAST OUR SHORT-TERM RELIANCE ON NUCLEAR POWER (UNTIL ADEQUATE SAFETY MEASURES CAN BE ADOPTED) AND MAXIMIZING THE DEVELOPMENT OF POTENTIAL OF ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SOLUTIONS--SOLAR ENERGY, ~~COAL~~ COAL AND ENERGY CONSERVATION.

THE 172 PAGE REPORT BY MASON WILLRICH STATES THAT A MAJOR WASTE PROBLEM CONFRONTS US TODAY AND WILL CONTINUE TO CONSTITUTE A HEALTH HAZARD "FOR HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS PERHAPS MILLIONS OF YEARS." IT CONCLUDES THAT THE GOVERNMENT'S PAST RECORD OF HANDLING WASTE IS A "CAUSE FOR CONCERN" AND "WILL BE INEFFECTIVE WITHOUT A DRASTIC REORGANIZATION OF THESE FUNCTIONS."

THE MAGNITUDE OF THE PROBLEM CANNOT BE OVEREMPHASIZED. GOVERNMENT MILITARY REACTORS CURRENTLY PRODUCE APPROXIMATELY 7.5 MILLION GALLONS OF LIQUID HIGH-LEVEL WASTE EACH YEAR AND COMMERCIAL REACTORS ARE LIKELY TO PRODUCE AS MUCH AS 60 MILLION GALLONS OF WASTE OVER THE NEXT 25 YEARS.

LOW-LEVEL WASTE--RAGS, MACHINERY, ETC.-- ALSO POSES STORAGE PROBLEMS. THE GOVERNMENT NOW PRODUCES 1.3 MILLION CUBIC FEET A YEAR OF LOW-LEVEL WASTE AND COMMERCIAL PLANTS ANTICIPATE PRODUCING 50 MILLION CUBIC FEET OVER THE NEXT 25 YEARS.

WHILE NO DEATHS OR INJURIES HAVE BEEN REPORTED TO DATE, THE IMMEDIACY OF THE PROBLEM IS ILLUSTRATED BY THE 18 LEAKS AT THE GOVERNMENT'S MAJOR STORAGE AREA IN HANFORD, WASHINGTON, RESULTING IN A LOSS OF 430,000 GALLONS OF HIGH-LEVEL WASTE INTO THE SOIL.

WITH DEATH, CANCER, GENETIC CHANGES AND ILL HEALTH AS SOME OF THE POTENTIAL RESULTS OF EXPOSURE TO RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS, THE GOVERNMENT MUST GIVE THIS ISSUE ATTENTION FORTHWITH AND MUST MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO MINIMIZE OUR NATION'S DEPENDENCE ON NUCLEAR POWER UNTIL OUR PEOPLE CAN BE GIVEN REASONABLE ASSURANCE OF ITS SAFETY.

SUBJECT: COUNCIL ON WAGE AND PRICE STABILITY REPORT ON
ALUMINUM PRICING

ATTACHED IS A STATEMENT ON THE FORD ADMINISTRATION'S ATTEMPTED SUPPRESSION OF A COUNCIL ON WAGE AND PRICE STABILITY REPORT ON ALUMINUM PRICING WHICH WAS REPORTED IN THE NEW YORK TIMES ON AUGUST 31. THE STORY PROVIDES A GOOD OPPORTUNITY TO ATTACK THE FORD ADMINISTRATION ON ITS ANTITRUST POLICY AND ITS GENERAL RELATIONSHIP WITH BIG BUSINESS.

THIS COULD BE ISSUED AT ANYTIME. IN ORDER TO TIE IT TO A BREAKING NEWS EVENT, HOWEVER, IT MIGHT BE RELEASED ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, WHEN THE SENATE IS EXPECTED TO VOTE ON THE ANTITRUST ENFORCEMENT BILL, OR ABOUT A WEEK LATER, WHEN IT WILL BE TAKEN UP IN THE HOUSE.

THE BEST ARGUMENT THE ADMINISTRATION MIGHT COME BACK WITH IS THAT IT ALWAYS INTENDED TO RELEASE THE REPORT AND THAT IT

IS THAT IT ALWAYS RELEASE THE REPORT AND THAT IT WOULD HAVE DELETED THE PORTION SUGGESTING THE POSSIBILITY OF BREAKING UP THE NOT OBJECTED TO IT, SINCE NEUTRAL ECONOMISTS TO WHOM THE REPORT WAS SENT ALSO SUGGESTED ITS DELETION.

A RESPONSE ALONG THESE LINES WOULD BE WEAK. THE ALUMINUM INDUSTRY IS NOTORIOUS FOR ITS DOMINATION BY THE BIG THREE. THE LARGEST, ALCOA, HAS BEEN SUCCESSFULLY PROSECUTED IN THE PAST FOR ATTEMPTED MONOPOLIZATION. THE INDUSTRY WOULD BE A PRIME CANDIDATE FOR THOROUGH INVESTIGATION IN THE CARTER ADMINISTRATION.

THE ADMINISTRATION WILL PROBABLY LEAVE THE ISSUE ALONE, SINCE IT WOULD NOT WANT TO APPEAR WEAK ON THE QUESTION OF ANTI-TRUST ENFORCEMENT AND DOES NOT HAVE MUCH POSITIVE TO OFFER.

FORD ADMINISTRATION SUPPRESSION OF ALUMINUM PRICING REPORT

THE FORD ADMINISTRATION'S SUPPRESSION OF A REPORT ON PRICING IN THE ALUMINUM INDUSTRY IS YET ANOTHER EXAMPLE OF THE FACT THAT THE ADMINISTRATION'S ECONOMIC AND REGULATORY POLICIES ARE CAPTIVE TO THE DICTATES OF BIG BUSINESS RATHER THAN CONSUMERS.

THE NEW YORK TIMES REPORTED RECENTLY THAT THE ADMINISTRATION HAS KEPT "BOTTLED UP" A COUNCIL ON WAGE AND PRICE STABILITY REPORT CRITICIZING ALUMINUM PRICING PRACTICES, BUT HAS FINALLY DECIDED TO RELEASE IT IN MID-SEPTEMBER, AFTER DELETION OF KEY SECTIONS, TO AVOID "ELECTION CAMPAIGN CHARGES."

THE COUNCIL'S FULL ORIGINAL REPORT SHOULD BE SENT BY PRESIDENT FORD TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, WITH INSTRUCTIONS THAT THE ATTORNEY GENERAL PROMPTLY INVESTIGATE THE FACTS AND DETERMINE WHETHER THE ANTI-TRUST LAWS HAVE BEEN VIOLATED AND CAN BE USED IN THIS CASE TO HOLD DOWN ALUMINUM PRICES.

IT IS TIME THERE IS RETURNED TO WASHINGTON AN ADMINISTRATION THAT IS NOT AFRAID TO PUT ON THE RECORD INFORMATION OF THIS TYPE, REGARDLESS OF THE BIG BUSINESS INTERESTS IT MIGHT OFFEND, AND TO TRUST IN THE ABILITY OF THE PUBLIC TO PARTICIPATE RESPONSIBLY IN THE FORMULATION OF ECONOMIC POLICY.

I HAVE ALSO POINTED OUT THE NEED TO STRENGTHEN THE COUNCIL OF WAGE AND PRICE STABILITY, SO THAT IT NOT ONLY WILL HAVE INCREASED AUTHORITY TO JAWBONE INDUSTRY OUT OF UNWARRANTED PRICE INCREASES, BUT ALSO TO MAKE IT A FOCAL POINT FOR THE COLLECTION OF INFORMATION AND THE STIMULATION OF DEBATE ON MATTERS SUCH AS PRICING PRACTICES IN MAJOR INDUSTRIES.

THE UNEDITED REPORT, PREPARED BY THE COUNCIL'S STAFF ECONOMISTS, POINTED OUT THAT ALUMINUM PRICES HAVE STEADILY INCREASE BY OVER 100% IN THE PAST 3 YEARS, DESPITE STEEPLY DECLINING DEMAND AND UNUSED CAPACITY. THE STAFF CONCLUDED THAT THIS UNUSUAL BEHAVIOR, PLUS SPECIFIC PRACTICES SUCH AS JOINT VENTURES AND COMMON USE OF BASE POINT PRICING, SUGGEST THAT PRICING IN THIS HIGHLY CONCENTRATED INDUSTRY HAS NOT BEEN THE PRODUCT OF FREE COMPETITION. THE COUNCIL'S INITIAL DRAFT SUGGESTED THAT THE GOVERNMENT SHOULD CONSIDER TAKING REGULATORY ACTION AGAINST THE INDUSTRY, INCLUDING BREAKING UP THE MAJOR FIRMS, BUT THIS SECTION WAS DELETED AFTER IT WAS CIRCULATED TO MEMBERS OF THE INDUSTRY AND STRONG PROTESTS WERE RECEIVED FROM THE TWO LARGEST FIRMS.

IT WOULD BE INAPPROPRIATE FOR ME TO COMMENT AT THIS TIME ON WHETHER IN FACT THE ALUMINUM INDUSTRY HAS ENGAGED IN PRICE FIXING, AS SUGGESTED BY THE REPORT. BUT IT IS NOT INAPPROPRIATE TO POINT OUT THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE ADMINISTRATION'S ACTIONS IN FIRST ATTEMPTING TO SUPPRESS AND THEN SIGNIFICANTLY ALTERING THE REPORT.

ONE OF THE MOST SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTORS TO INFLATION IS ANTI-COMPETITIVE PRICING PRACTICES IN CONCENTRATED INDUSTRIES, PARTICULARLY THOSE INVOLVING BASIC MATERIALS LIKE ALUMINUM. THE FORD RECORD ON ANTITRUST ENFORCEMENT HAS BEEN ABYSMAL, PARTICULARLY WHEN IT COMES TO TAKING ON THE MAJOR CONCENTRATED INDUSTRIES, AND ITS ACTION HERE REFLECTS THAT WE CAN EXPECT BUSINESS AS USUAL IF THE FORD-DOLE TICKET IS ELECTED. MOREOVER, THE ADMINISTRATION'S PRACTICE OF ALLOWING IMPORTANT REPORTS OF THIS TYPE TO BE CIRCULATED TO THE INDUSTRY FOR ITS CLEARANCE, WITHOUT AT LEAST ALLOWING CONSUMER ORGANIZATIONS THE SAME OPPORTUNITY, HARDLY PROVIDES THE TYPE OF BALANCED INPUT THAT IS NECESSARY IF THE GOVERNMENT IS TO BE RESPONSIVE TO THE PEOPLE, RATHER THAN BIG BUSINESS ALONE.

I BELIEVE THE COUNCIL'S REPORT POINTS UP THE NEED TO VIGOROUSLY EXPLORE THE ACCURACY OF ITS FINDINGS BY THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT, RATHER THAN TO SWEEP THEM UNDER THE RUG, AND DETERMINE WHETHER EXISTING ANTITRUST LAWS HAVE BEEN VIOLATED. I HAVE POINTED OUT ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS THAT VIGOROUS ENFORCEMENT OF THE ANTITRUST LAWS WILL BE A HIGH PRIORITY OF A CARTER-MONDALE ADMINISTRATION.

STATEMENT BY GOVERNOR CARTER UPON RELEASE OF STUDY OF NIXON-FORD ECONOMIC RECORD

GOVERNOR JIMMY CARTER, THE DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE, TODAY RELEASED WHAT HE CALLED A "STARTLING" STUDY PREPARED BY HIS STAFF OF THE ECONOMIC RECORD OF THE NIXON-FORD ADMINISTRATION, WHICH CARTER TERMED "THE WORST OVERALL ECONOMIC RECORD SINCE THE GREAT DEPRESSION." CARTER WAS SHARPLY CRITICAL OF "A FAILURES OF POLICY AND DECISION-MAKING" DURING THE NIXON-FORD ADMINISTRATION WHICH HE STATED WERE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE "DISASTROUS# RECORD."

THE TEXT OF GOVERNOR CARTER'S STATEMENT FOLLOWS:

"I THINK THIS STUDY IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE THE PUBLIC DESERVES A DETAILED EXAMINATION OF THE RECORD OF PERFORMANCE OF THE USE CANDIDATES WHO WOULD SEEK TO LEAD THEM. THE STUDY IS AN EFFORT TO DOCUMENT WHAT HAS HAPPENED TO THE ECONOMY UNDER THE ADMINISTRATION OF RICHARD NIXON AND GERALD FORD.

"FRANKLY, THE RESULTS OF THE ANALYSIS ARE STARTLING. THE NIXON-FORD YEARS HAVE BURDENED THE COUNTRY WITH THE WORST OVERALL ECONOMIC RECORD SINCE THE GREAT DEPRESSION. THE FOLLOWING ARE SOME OF THE STUDY'S MOST SIGNIFICANT FINDINGS:

--DURING MR. FORD'S PERIOD IN OFFICE, THE NATION HAS SUFFERED THE WORST COMBINATION OF UNEMPLOYMENT AND INFLATION UNDER ANY ADMINISTRATION IN MORE THAN 50 YEARS.

THE 6 1/2% AVERAGE RATE OF INFLATION DURING THE PERIOD 1968-76 IS THREE TIMES AS HIGH AS THE AVERAGE RATE OF INFLATION DURING THE KENNEDY-JOHNSON YEARS. A 1968 DOLLAR IS TODAY WORTH 61 CENTS.

--THE OVERALL REAL GROWTH OF THE ECONOMY HAS BEEN SLIGHTLY OVER 2% FOR THE LAST EIGHT YEARS, ABOUT HALF THE GROWTH RATE DURING THE KENNEDY-JOHNSON YEARS.

THE CORRECT POSITION FOR US NOW TO TAKE IS THAT THE RATIO OF INSTRUCTORS PLUS SUPPORT PERSONNEL IS EITHER 1.5/1 OR 2.2/1, DEPENDING UPON WHETHER ONE USES THE PENTAGON'S OLD OR NEW ACCOUNTING CATEGORIES. THE MESSAGE IN EITHER EVENT IS THE SAME: TRAINING PROGRAMS USE FAR TOO MUCH PERSONNEL AND ARE EXTREMELY COSTLY. (NO ONE HAS CHALLENGED OUR PROJECTION OF A \$1 BILLION SAVING FROM MOVING THE RATIO TO 3/1 FROM 1.5/1.

ONE CAN COMPARE THE RATIO, HOWEVER FIGURED, IN DOD, WITH THE RATIO (STUDENTS TO TEACHERS PLUS SUPPORT PERSONNEL) IN PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS--19/1. WHILE THERE MAY BE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE CONTENT OF HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS AND THE CONTENT OF DOD TRAINING PROGRAMS, IT WOULD APPEAR DOUBTFUL THAT THE DIFFERENCES COULD POSSIBLY JUSTIFY THE GAP BETWEEN 1.5/1 OR 2.2/1 AND 19/1.

C. COST OVERRUNS

EVANS AND NOVAK ALSO CRITICIZED US FOR UNDERSTATING THE CURRENT COST OF OVERRUNS. THEIR FIGURE (\$13.4 BILLION) APPEARS TO HAVE COME FROM THE SEPTEMBER 3 EDITION OF A PENTAGON REPORT CALLED THE SELECTED ACQUISITION REPORT ("SAR"), WHICH IS PUBLISHED QUARTERLY. (AS NOTED, THE SAR IS CLASSIFIED, BUT A SAR SUMMARY IS RELEASED.) OUR SPEECH WAS GIVEN BEFORE PUBLICATION OF THIS REPORT, ON AUGUST 24, AND OUR FIGURE OF \$10.7 BILLION WAS BASED ON THE DATA PUBLISHED AT THAT TIME.

HENCE, NOT ONLY WAS OUR FIGURE ACCURATE, BUT THE NEW FIGURES SHOW A REMARKABLE INCREASE IN WASTE DURING THE THREE-MONTH PERIOD BETWEEN THE PUBLICATION OF THE TWO REPORTS. (THE FIRST REPORT, SHOWING AN OVERRUN TOTAL OF \$10.7 BILLION, WAS PUBLISHED MAY 14, 1976, AND ITS FIGURES WERE CALCULATED AS OF MARCH 31, 1976. THE SECOND REPORT, PUBLISHED SEPTEMBER 3, 1976, WAS CALCULATED AS OF JUNE 30, 1976.

ACTUALLY, IT APPEARS THAT THE EVANS AND NOVAK 13.4 FIGURE IS OVERSTATED, AS IT APPEARS TO INCLUDE BOTH PURE COST INCREASES AND QUANTITY INCREASES; QUANTITY INCREASES SHOULD BE EXCLUDED FROM OVERRUN CALCULATIONS. LES ASPIN CALCULATES THE CORRECT FIGURE FOR PURE COST INCREASES IS \$972 MILLION. IN OTHER WORDS

THE PUREC
THE PURE COST INCREASE IS ALMOST \$1 BILLION IN THAT SHORT SPAN OF TIME.

ASPIN POINTS OUT THAT, WHILE THIS IS BUT ONE PERCENT OF THE CURRENT ESTIMATED TOTAL PROGRAM COST OF THE PROGRAMS INCLUDED, IT IS NEVERTHELESS SIGNIFICANT. A ONE PERCENT PER QUARTER INCREASE IN THE COST OF A WEAPONS SYSTEM WHICH TOOK TEN YEARS TO DEVELOP WOULD AMOUNT TO 50% OVER THE LIFE OF THE PROGRAM.

ASPIN ALSO NOTES TWO SYSTEMS IN WHICH LARGE INCREASES OCCURRED IN THE F-15 PROGRAM, INCREASES TOTALED \$324 MILLION IN BASE YEAR (FY 70) DOLLARS OVER THIS THREE-MONTH PERIOD (\$7,189 MILLION TO \$7,513 MILLION). THIS EQUALS 4 1/2 PERCENT OF THE COST OF THE PROGRAM IN JUST ONE QUARTER. MOREOVER, HE RELATES, THE SAR SUMMARY ST STATES THAT ADDITIONAL COST INCREASES OF "APPROXIMATELY \$500 MILLION ARE ALREADY ANTICIPATED, WITH \$200 MILLION DUE TO INFLATION AND \$300 MILLION DUE TO REAL COST OVERRUNS.

CONTINUOUS INTER-@-MOQ@-RUST-ASS-FOR-... INC.

ASPIN ALSO NOTES THAT THE COST ESTIMATE FOR THE TRIDENT PROGRAM IS UP \$188.5 MILLION IN BASE YEAR 1974 DOLLARS, DESPITE A REDUCTION OF \$80 MILLION BECAUSE OF A 12 MISSILE NET REDUCTION IN PROGRAM QUANTITY. ACCORDING TO THE SAR SUMMARY, THE CAUSES FOR THE INCREASE INCLUDE:

- (1) DELAY IN THE OPERATIONAL AVAILABILITY DATE OF THE MISSILE;
- (2) A 4-MONTH DELAY EXPECTED IN DELIVERY OF THE LEAD SHIP;
- (3) A RESULTING REVISED ESTIMATE OF SYSTEM INITIAL OPERATIONAL CAPABILITY FROM APRIL TO SEPTEMBER 1979.

IN ANY STATEMENT WE MAKE ON THIS ISSUE, WE MAY WANT TO USE A QUOTE EXHUMED BY BLECHMAN BY CONGRESSMAN DONALD RUMSFELD ON MARCH 13, 1963 ON THE HOUSE FLOOR, WHEN HE VOTED AGAINST THE RF-70 INCLUDED IN H.R. 2440:

"NATIONAL DEFENSE IS SACROSANCT, BUT WASTE IN DEFENSE SPENDING IS NOT. WASTE AND INEFFICIENCY ARE ALWAYS PRESENT IN A FIFTY BILLION DOLLAR PLUS OPERATION."

RESOLUTION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE

NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS

SEPTEMBER 16, 1976

AT THE INVITATION OF THE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES OF THE TWO MAJOR PARTIES THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF OUR BISHOPS CONFERENCE HAS RECENTLY ADDRESSED CRITICAL CONTEMPORARY ISSUES IN FRANK AND COURTEOUS DIALOGUE WITH THEM. WE UNITE OURSELVES WITH THIS EFFORT BY OUR EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO MAKE KNOWN OUR POSITION AND CLARIFY ISSUES.

DESPITE SOME PUBLIC MISPERCEPTIONS CONCERNING THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF THE MEETINGS WITH THE CANDIDATES, WE NOTE WITH GRATITUDE THAT THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE HAS CLEARLY ARTICULATED OUR CONFERENCE'S POLICY ON A BROAD RANGE OF FOREIGN AND DOMESTIC ISSUES WITHOUT ENDORSING OR OPPOSING EITHER CANDIDATE OR PARTY. THERE ARE ELEMENTS OF AGREEMENT AND DISAGREEMENT ON MANY ISSUES BETWEEN OUR POSITIONS AND THOSE OF THE MAJOR PARTIES, THEIR PLATFORMS AND THEIR CANDIDATES.

GOVERNMENT HAS A LEGITIMATE AND INDEED ESSENTIAL ROLE IN THE SOLUTION OF SOCIAL PROBLEMS AND THE FOSTERING OF HUMAN RIGHTS. OUR CONCERN WITH GOVERNMENT AND THE POLITICAL PROCESS IS BASED UPON THIS FACT AND HAS

NO CONNECTION WITH POLITICAL PARTISANSHIP.

ABORTION AND THE NEED FOR A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO PROTECT THE UNBORN ARE AMONG OUR CONCERNS. SO ARE THE ISSUES OF UNEMPLOYMENT ADEQUATE EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL, AN EQUITABLE FOOD POLICY BOTH DOMESTIC AND WORLDWIDE, THE RIGHT TO A DECENT HOME AND HEALTH CARE, HUMAN RIGHTS ACROSS THE GLOBE, INTELLIGENT ARMS LIMITATION AND MANY OTHER SOCIAL JUSTICE ISSUES. WE WISH TO EMPHASIZE THAT OUR PROFOUND CONCERN FOR THE SPECIFIC ISSUE OF ABORTION IS BASED ON THE FACT THAT LIFE IS NOT ONLY A VALUE IN ITSELF BUT IS ABSOLUTELY FUNDAMENTAL TO THE REALIZATION OF ALL OTHER HUMAN VALUES AND HUMAN RIGHTS.

THE CATHOLIC BISHOPS OF THE UNITED STATES HAVE OFTEN PUBLICLY STATED AND WE HERE REAFFIRM -- DEEP COMMITMENT TO THE SANCTITY, DIGNITY AND QUALITY OF HUMAN LIFE AT ALL STAGES OF DEVELOPMENT AS WELL AS TO LEGISLATION AND PUBLIC POLICY WHICH PROTECT AND PROMOTE THESE VALUES IN ALL TEMPORARY CONTEXTS. MANY OF THE SPECIFIC ISSUES IN WHICH THESE VALUES ARE AT STAKE WERE DISCUSSED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE UNITED STATES CATHOLIC CONFERENCE IN ITS STATEMENT ON POLITICAL RESPONSIBILITY ADOPTED MAY 6, 1976. OUR CONCERN ON THE BROAD RANGE OF ISSUES WAS ENUMERATED IN TESTIMONY PRESENTED TO THE DEMOCRATIC PLATFORM COMMITTEE ON MAY 20, 1976, AND TO THE REPUBLICAN PLATFORM COMMITTEE ON AUGUST 9, 1976. MOST RECENTLY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE HAS ONCE AGAIN SPOKEN TO MANY OF THESE MATTERS.

AS BISHOPS WE HAVE A DUTY TO MAKE CLEAR THE MORAL AND RELIGIOUS DIMENSIONS OF SECULAR ISSUES, TO POINT TO GOD'S WORD AS AN AUTHENTIC NORM FOR SOCIAL AND POLITICAL LIFE, AND TO MAKE CLEAR THE PRACTICAL REQUIREMENTS WHICH SPIRITUAL AND MORAL VALUES IMPOSE UPON EFFORTS TO ACHIEVE A MORE JUST SOCIAL ORDER. AT THE SAME TIME, WE ARE NOT SUPPORTING RELIGIOUS BLOC VOTING NOR ARE WE INSTRUCTING PEOPLE FOR WHOM TO VOTE. RATHER, WE URGE THAT CITIZENS MAKE THIS DECISION FOR THEMSELVES IN AN INFORMED AND CONSCIENTIOUS MANNER, IN LIGHT OF CANDIDATES' POSITIONS ON THE ISSUES AS WELL AS THEIR PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS.

THE ISSUES WITH WHICH THE CATHOLIC BISHOPS ARE CONCERNED, BOTH AS RELIGIOUS AND MORAL LEADERS AND AS CITIZENS, AND TO WHICH THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE HAS SPOKEN IN RECENT DAYS, WILL REMAIN AS VALID AND CRITICAL AFTER THE ELECTIONS AS THEY ARE NOW. WE SHALL CONTINUE TO ADDRESS THESE ISSUES FACING OUR NATION BY ALL APPROPRIATE MEANS AT OUR DISPOSAL.

THE TAX FOUNDATION, A NONPROFIT RESEARCH ORGANIZATION TODAY REPORTED THAT CONGRESS SPENT NEARLY \$1 BILLION ON ITSELF IN THE LAST FISCAL YEAR, ALMOST TRIPLE WHAT IT SPENT IN 1970 AND MORE THAN FIVE TIMES WHAT IT SPENT IN 1960. THE FOUNDATION SAID MOST OF THE SPENDING INCREASE WAS DUE TO THE "SUBSTANTIAL GROWTH OF LEGISLATIVE BRANCH EMPLOYMENT AS WELL AS SIGNIFICANT INCREASES IN SALARIES AND OTHER COSTS."

THE TOTAL CONGRESSIONAL EXPENDITURE OF NEARLY \$925 MILLION, WHICH WILL SOON REACH \$1 BILLION A YEAR, WORKS OUT TO ABOUT \$4.30 FOR EVERY MAN, WOMAN AND CHILD IN THE COUNTRY.

YOU MAY KNOW THAT CONGRESS DETERMINES ITS OWN BUDGET, WHICH, BY LAW, MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE PRESIDENT'S BUDGET SUBMISSION EXACTLY AS PROPOSED. IT MAKES ITS OWN RULES, DETERMINES ITS OWN STAFF AND SALARY LEVELS, PROVIDES ITSELF ALLOWANCES AND PERQUISITES, ETC.

THE SUNSET LEGISLATIVE CONCEPT WOULD REQUIRE THIS NEW WORKING RELATIONSHIP.

STATEMENT ON REMOVING THE FBI DIRECTOR

THE FBI, WHICH MUST BE LOOKED UPON AS A BASTION OF HONESTY, DECENCY AND COMPETENCE, IF IT IS TO HAVE THE TRUST AND CONFIDENCE OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, HAS IN RECENT YEARS HAD ITS REPUTATION DECLINE TO AN ALL-TIME LOW WITH THE SHOCKING DISCLOSURE OF INNUMERABLE INSTANCES OF ILLEGAL BREAK-INS, MISUSE OF FUNDS AND OTHER ABUSES. THE RECENT ALLEGATIONS CONCERNING THE RECEIPT OF GIFTS BY THE DIRECTOR FROM HIS SUBORDINATES AND GOVERNMENT INSTALLATION OF VALANCES IN THE DIRECTOR'S HOME ONLY SERVE TO SHARPEN THE DECLINE.

WHETHER KELLEY'S CONDUCT RISES TO A LEVEL OF CRIMINAL CONDUCT IS NOT THE REAL ISSUE.

THE ISSUE IS WHETHER THE RECENT DISCLOSURES CONCERNING KELLEY, COUPLED WITH HIS RECORD OVER THE LAST THREE YEARS, DEMONSTRATE SUCH A LACK OF SENSITIVITY, LEADERSHIP, AND COMMITMENT TO AGGRESSIVE MANAGEMENT TECHNIQUES THAT HE SHOULD BE REPLACED. I THINK THE RECORD SPEAKS FOR ITSELF.

1. ILLEGAL KICKBACKS AND MISUSE OF FUNDS. THERE HAVE BEEN SERIOUS ALLEGATIONS RECENTLY OF ILLEGAL KICKBACKS AND MISUSE OF BUREAU FUNDS CONCERNING HIGH LEVEL PERSONNEL. IN RECENT WEEKS, APPARENTLY IN CONNECTION WITH THESE ALLEGATIONS, KEY KELLEY PERSONNEL HAVE VACATED THEIR POSITIONS ✓

--THE NO. 2 MAN IN THE BUREAU HAS BEEN FIRED

--THE NO. 3 MAN, IN CHARGE OF ALL ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT DIVISIONS, HAS RETIRED.

-- THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR IN CHARGE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISION HAS RESIGNED.

--THE SECTION CHIEF OF THE EXHIBITS SECTION WAS FIRED AND PLEADED GUILTY TO A CHARGE OF MISAPPROPRIATION OF GOVERNMENT FUNDS.

2. UNAUTHORIZED BURGLARIES. THE CIVIL RIGHTS DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE IS NOW INVESTIGATING CHARGES OF NUMEROUS UNAUTHORIZED BURGLARIES, MAIL THEFTS AND ILLEGAL WIRETAPS OF DOMESTIC POLITICAL GROUPS UP THROUGH APRIL OF THIS YEAR. APPROXIMATELY 30 PRESENT AND FORMER AGENTS ARE THE SUBJECT OF A GRAND JURY INQUIRY. KELLEY'S CLAIM OF A LACK OF KNOWLEDGE OF THESE OCCURENCES DURING HIS OWN REGIME, WHILE EXCULPATORY OF HIMSELF, DEMONSTRATES HIS FAILURE TO BRING THE BUREAU UNDER CONTROL.

3. LACK OF CHANGE IN THE BUREAU. SINCE KELLEY BECAME DIRECTOR IN 1973, HE HAS FAILED TO BRING NEW LEADERSHIP TO THE BUREAU. HE HAS PROMOTED ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY FROM WITHIN AND HAS THUS STRAPPED THE BUREAU WITH THE TACTICS, VIEWS AND JUDGMENT OF THE OLD HOOVERITES. STRUCTURAL CHANGES HAVE BEEN FEW, TOO LITTLE AND TOO LATE, AND USUALLY IN RESPONSE TO CONGRESSIONAL PRESSURE. MOVING BODIES AROUND, SUCH AS THE RECENT SHIFT OF THE DOMESTIC INTELLIGENCE INVESTIGATIONS GROUP TO THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE DIVISION, DOES NOT EFFECTUATE NEEDED CHANGE IN PERSONNEL OR OVERALL PHILOSOPHY FOR HANDLING INTELLIGENCE INVESTIGATIONS. ✓

4. KELLEY'S ACTION ON SOLICITATION OF FUNDS. KELLEY RECENTLY AUTHORIZED A PRIVATE ORGANIZATION TO SOLICIT FUNDS IN THE BUREAU'S 59 FIELD OFFICES FOR THE DEFENSE OF BUREAU AGENTS ACCUSED OF ILLEGAL BURGLARIES AND OTHER ILLEGAL ACTS. AS ONE AGENT JUSTIFIABLY HAS ASKED: "ARE MEMBERS OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SUPPOSED TO CHIP IN TO PAY FOR PEOPLE CHAGED WITH CRIMES?" OTHERS HAVE CLAIMED THAT KELLEY'S CIRCULATION OF A MEMO STATING THAT PARTICIPATION IS VOLUNTARY DOES NOT DISPEL THE FEELING AMONG AGENTS THAT THEY ARE EXPECTED TO CONTRIBUTE. ✓

5. MISALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. WITHIN THE LAST WEEK, IT HAS BEEN DISCLOSED THAT 66 BUREAU AGENTS ARE NOW INFILTRATING A FRINGE POLITICAL PARTY, DESPITE THE FACT THAT 38 YEARS OF SURVEILLANCE HAVE NOT RESULTED IN A SINGLE ARREST OR EVIDENCE OF WRONGDOING. IS THIS A PROPER ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES IN VIEW OF THE SERIOUS CRIME PROBLEMS WE FACE TODAY?

THE TIME HAS COME TO REVERSE THE DIRECTION OF THE BUREAU. WITH A 58 PERCENT INCREASE IN CRIME OVER THE LAST EIGHT YEARS, A STRONG, WELL-MANAGED AND RESPECTED FBI IS CRUCIAL.

HOWEVER, IT WILL BE NO SIMPLE TASK TO TRANSFORM THE FBI INTO AN INSTITUTION KNOWN FOR THE EFFECTIVENESS AND CREDIBILITY OF ITS LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS AND THE HONESTY AND DECENCY OF ITS PERSONNEL. ✓

IT WILL REQUIRE SOME REAL HOUSECLEANING AT THE MANAGEMENT LEVEL AND SOME MEANINGFUL CHANGES IN POLICY. MOST IMPORTANTLY, IT WILL REQUIRE A FIRM COMMITMENT TO COMPETENT AND UNTAINTED LEADERSHIP AND TO AGGRESSIVE MANAGEMENT AND MONITORING OF BUREAU ACTIVITIES. THE PRESENT LEADERSHIP OF THE FBI LACKS THE COMMITMENT, JUDGMENT, LEADERSHIP SKILLS, OBJECTIVITY AND INTEGRITY NEEDED TO CARRY OUT THESE REFORMS. AS PRESIDENT, MY FIRST ACT OF REFORMATION WOULD BE TO CHANGE THAT LEADERSHIP.

AS YOU WILL NOTE, WE BELIEVE THAT THE RECENT KELLEY IMPROPRIETIES ARE MERELY INDICATIVE OF KELLEY'S LACK OF SENSITIVITY AND LEADERSHIP AND THAT YOU SHOULD USE A BROADER ATTACK IN CALLING FOR HIS REMOVAL.

STATEMENT ON REMOVING THE FBI DIRECTOR

THE FBI, WHICH MUST BE LOOKED UPON AS A BASTION OF HONESTY, DECENCY AND COMPETENCE, IF IT IS TO HAVE THE TRUST AND CONFIDENCE OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, HAS IN RECENT YEARS HAD ITS REPUTATION DECLINE TO AN ALL-TIME LOW WITH THE SHOCKING DISCLOSURE OF INNUMERABLE INSTANCES OF ILLEGAL BREAK-INS, MISUSE OF FUNDS AND OTHER ABUSES. THE RECENT ALLEGATIONS CONCERNING THE RECEIPT OF GIFTS BY THE DIRECTOR FROM HIS SUBORDINATES AND GOVERNMENT INSTALLATION OF VALANCES IN THE DIRECTOR'S HOME ONLY SERVE TO SHARPEN THE DECLINE.

WHETHER KELLEY'S CONDUCT RISES TO A LEVEL OF CRIMINAL CONDUCT IS NOT THE REAL ISSUE.

THE ISSUE IS WHETHER THE RECENT DISCLOSURES CONCERNING KELLEY, COUPLED WITH HIS RECORD OVER THE LAST THREE YEARS, DEMONSTRATE SUCH A LACK OF SENSITIVITY, LEADERSHIP, AND COMMITMENT TO AGGRESSIVE MANAGEMENT TECHNIQUES THAT HE SHOULD BE REPLACED. I THINK THE RECORD SPEAKS FOR ITSELF.

1. ILLEGAL KICKBACKS AND MISUSE OF FUNDS. THERE HAVE BEEN SERIOUS ALLEGATIONS RECENTLY OF ILLEGAL KICKBACKS AND MISUSE OF BUREAU FUND CONCERNING HIGH LEVEL PERSONNEL. IN RECENT WEEKS, APPARENTLY IN CONNECTION WITH THESE ALLEGATIONS KEY KELLEY PERSONNEL HAVE VACATE THEIR POSITIONS

—THE NO. 2 MAN IN THE BUREAU HAS BEEN FIRED

—THE NO. 3 MAN, IN CHARGE OF ALL ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT DIVISIONS, HAS RETIRED.

—THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR IN CHARGE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISION HAS RESIGNED.

—THE SECTION CHIEF OF THE EXHIBITS SECTION WAS FIRED AND PLEADED GUILTY TO A CHARGE OF MISAPPROPRIATION OF GOVERNMENT FUNDS.

2. UNAUTHORIZED BURGLARIES. THE CIVIL RIGHTS DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE IS NOW INVESTIGATING CHARGES OF NUMEROUS UNAUTHORIZED BURGLARIES, MAIL THEFTS AND ILLEGAL WIRETAPS OF DOMESTIC POLITICAL GROUPS UP THROUGH APRIL OF THIS YEAR.

APPROXIMATELY 30 PRESENT AND FORMER AGENTS ARE THE SUBJECT OF A GRAND JURY INQUIRY. KELLEY'S CLAIM OF A LACK OF KNOWLEDGE OF THESE OCCURENCES DURING HIS OWN REGIME, WHILE EXCULPATORY OF HIMSELF, DEMONSTRATES HIS FAILURE TO BRING THE BUREAU UNDER CONTROL

3. LACK OF CHANGE IN THE BUREAU SINCE KELLEY BECAME DIRECTOR

3. LACK OF CHANGE IN THE BUREAU. SINCE KELLEY BECAME DIRECTOR IN 1973, HE HAS FAILED TO BRING NEW LEADERSHIP TO THE BUREAU. HE HAS PROMOTED ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY FROM WITHIN AND HAS THUS STRAPPED THE BUREAU WITH THE TACTICS, VIEWS AND JUDGMENT OF THE OLD HOOVER IT S. STRUCTURAL CHANGES HAVE BEEN FEW, TOO LITTLE AND TOO LATE, AND USUALLY IN RESPONSE TO CONGRESSIONAL PRESSURE. MOVING BODIES AROUND, SUCH AS THE RECENT SHIFT OF THE DOMESTIC INTELLIGENCE INVESTIGATIONS GROUP TO THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE DIVISION, DOES NOT EFFECTUATE NEEDED CHANGE IN PERSONNEL OR OVERALL PHILOSOPHY FOR HANDLING INTELLIGENCE INVESTIGATIONS.

4. KELLEY'S ACTION ON SOLICITATION OF FUNDS. KELLEY RECENTLY AUTHORIZED A PRIVATE ORGANIZATION TO SOLICIT FUNDS IN THE BUREAU'S 59 FIELD OFFICES FOR THE DEFENSE OF BUREAU AGENTS ACCUSED OF ILLEGAL BURGLARIES AND OTHER ILLEGAL ACTS. AS ONE AGENT JUSTIFIABLY HAS ASKED: "ARE MEMBERS OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SUPPOSED TO CHIP IN TO PAY FOR PEOPLE CHARGED WITH CRIMES?" OTHERS HAVE CLAIMED THAT KELLEY'S CIRCULATION OF A MEMO STATING THAT PARTICIPATION IS VOLUNTARY DOES NOT DISPEL THE FEELING AMONG AGENTS THAT THEY ARE EXPECTED TO CONTRIBUTE.

5. MISALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. WITHIN THE LAST WEEK, IT HAS BEEN DISCLOSED THAT 66 BUREAU AGENTS ARE NOW INFILTRATING A FRINGE POLITICAL PARTY, DESPITE THE FACT THAT 38 YEARS OF SURVEILLANCE HAVE NOT RESULTED IN A SINGLE ARREST OR EVIDENCE OF WRONGDOING. IS THIS A PROPER ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES IN VIEW OF THE SERIOUS CRIME PROBLEMS WE FACE TODAY?

THE TIME HAS COME TO REVERSE THE DIRECTION OF THE BUREAU. WITH A 58 PERCENT INCREASE IN CRIME OVER THE LAST EIGHT YEARS, A STRONG, WELL-MANAGED AND RESPECTED FBI IS CRUCIAL. HOWEVER, IT WILL BE NO SIMPLE TASK TO TRANSFORM THE FBI INTO AN INSTITUTION KNOWN FOR THE EFFECTIVENESS AND CREDIBILITY OF ITS LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS AND THE HONESTY AND DECENCY OF ITS PERSONNEL.

IT WILL REQUIRE SOME REAL HOUSECLEANING AT THE MANAGEMENT LEVEL AND SOME MEANINGFUL CHANGES IN POLICY. MOST IMPORTANTLY, IT WILL REQUIRE A FIRM COMMITMENT TO COMPETENT AND UNTAINTED LEADERSHIP AND TO AGGRESSIVE MANAGEMENT AND MONITORING OF BUREAU ACTIVITIES. THE PRESENT LEADERSHIP OF THE FBI LACKS THE COMMITMENT, JUDGMENT, LEADERSHIP SKILLS, OBJECTIVITY AND INTEGRITY NEEDED TO CARRY OUT THESE REFORMS. AS PRESIDENT, MY FIRST ACT OF REFORMATION WOULD BE TO CHANGE THAT LEADERSHIP.
