EXPLANATION FOR NEED OF STATEMENT:

THE HYDE AMENDMENT NOW BEFORE CONGRESS WOULD PLACE AN ABSOLUTE BAN ON USE OF FEDERAL MONIES FOR ABORTION SERVICES WITH NO QUALIFICATIONS. THUS EVEN IN CASES WHERE THE WOMAN C WOULD DIE IF NOT ABORTED, OR WHERE THERE WAS RAPE OR INCEST AN ABORTION WOULD BE PROHIBITED AND A POOR WOMAN COULD NOT BE TREATED UNDER MEDICAID. EVEN THOUGH THERE IS TALK OF ADDING AN EXAMPTION TO COVER A LIFE-SAVING SITUATION, CONGRESS IS MOVING IN AN AREA WHERE THERE ARE BOTH FEDERAL DISTRICT COURT DECISIONS OPPOSING SUCH A RULE AND A PENDING SUPREME COURT DECISION.

FEDERAL COURTS IN SEVEN 8

(7) STATES HAVE RULED ON CONSTITUTIONAL GROUNDS THAT THE STATES MAY NOT EXEMPT COVERAGE OF ABORTION SERVICES UNDER MEDICAID. ON A STATUTORY BASIS, THAT IS, WHETHER THE LANGUAGE OF TITLE XIX REQUIRES SUCH PAYMENT, THE COURTS ARE DIVIDED. BY THE END OF THIS TERM THE SUPREME COURT WILL HAVE RULED ON THIS QUESTION.

A STATEMENT SHOULD BE AVAILABLE BECAUSE PROPONENTS OF THE HYDE AMENDMENT ARE PUBLICLY JUSTIFYING THEIR POSITION AS BEING BASED ON YOUR POSITION. IN ADDITION, MANY WHO WOULD NOT NORMALLY RAISE THEIR VOICES IN SUPPORT OF THE ABORTION ISSUE, ARE CONCERNED ABOUT A "TWO-CLASS" SYSTEM OF CARE. THE STATEMENT SHOULD NOT BE USED UNLESS NECESSARYL

PLANNING, ADOPTION PROCEDURES AND CONTRACEPTION. I DO NOT PERSONALLY FAVOR THE USE OF MEDICAID FUNDS FOR ABORTION. BUT IN MY VIEW IT WOULD BE WISE FOR CONGRESS TO REFRAIN FROM PLACING A BAN ON THE USE OF MEDICAID MONEY AT THIS TIME UNTIL THE SUPREME COURT CONSIDERS THE LEGALITY OF SUCH A LIMITATION AS IT HAS AGREED TO DO

SUCH A PROHIBITION AS IT HAS AGREED TO DO  
THIS TERM. SEVERAL FEDERAL COURTS HAVE ALREADY  
PLACED IN QUESTION THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF  
SUCH A PROHIBITION. LEGISLATING ON THIS  
MATTER NOW ONLY SERVES  
SERVES TO CONFUSE AN ALREADY

MEMORANDUM

TO: MILT GWIRTZMAN AND PAT ANDERSON

RE: EVANS AND NOVAK CRITIQUE OF LEGION SPEECH DEFENSE SAVINGS

IN THE AMERICAN LEGION SPEECH, DELIVERED AUGUST 24, 1976, WE IDENTIFIED THREE AREAS OF SIGNIFICANT WASTE IN THE DEFENSE BUDGET. THE THREE AREAS WERE: EXCESSIVELY SHORT "TOURS OF DUTY;" EXCESSIVE TRAINING PERSONNEL IN TRAINING PROGRAMS; AND COST-OVERRUNS. ON SEPTEMBER 6, 1976, EVANS AND NOVAK RAN A COLUMN ATTACKING THE ACCURACY OF THESE FIGURES, ENTITLED "CARTER'S ADVICE FROM BROOKINGS." (EVIDENTLY, THE PENTAGON SOURCE WHICH PRESUMABLY GAVE EVANS & NOVAK THEIR INFORMATION IDENTIFIED OUR SOURCE AS BROOKINGS' ANALYSIS OF THESE ISSUES. IN FACT, BROOKINGS (BARRY BLECHMAN) WAS THE SOURCE FOR THE "TOURS OF DUTY" NUMBER AND THE TRAINING PROGRAM NUMBER. LES ASPIN WAS THE SOURCE FOR THE OVERRUN NUMBER.) THIS MEMORANDUM WILL EXPLAIN THE ORIGIN OF THE FIGURES IN THE SPEECH, AND PROVIDE A BASIS FOR DEALING WITH THESE ISSUES IN THE FUTURE.

IN BRIEF SUMMARY: OUR FIGURES ON THE TRAINING PROGRAM AND "TOURS OF DUTY" ISSUES CAN BE QUESTIONED. HOWEVER, THEY ARE MUCH CLOSER TO THE MARK THAN THE COUNTER-FIGURES STATED IN EVANS & NOVAK'S COLUMN. THE COST OVERRUN FIGURE TAKEN FROM ASPIN WAS PRECISELY ACCURATE AS OF THE TIME OF THE SPEECH; THE NEWER (AND HIGHER) FIGURE FOR OVERRUNS GIVEN IN EVANS & NOVAK APPEARS TO HAVE COME FROM A NEW PENTAGON STANDARD ACQUISITION REPORT ("SAR") ISSUED SEPTEMBER 3, 1976 (AFTER THE SPEECH), WHICH REVEALED A HUGE JUMP IN OVERRUN COSTS DURING THE THREE-MONTH PERIOD FOLLOWING THE PREVIOUS REPORT (ON WHICH ASPIN HAD RELIED IN ADVISING US). (SAR REPORTS ARE CLASSIFIED, BUT A SAR SUMMARY IS PUBLISHED.)

IN SUMMARY, WE CAN CONCLUDE: FIRST, THERE IS AGREEMENT BETWEEN OURSELVES AND EVANS & NOVAK (AND THEIR PENTAGON SOURCE) THAT THERE IS TREMENDOUS WASTE IN EACH OF THE THREE AREAS IDENTIFIED IN THE SPEECH; SECOND, AS TO TWO OF THOSE AREAS (TIME BETWEEN MOVES AND TRAINING PERSONNEL) THERE IS DISPUTE AS TO THE EXTENT OF THE WASTE -- THESE DISPUTES TURN LARGELY ON TECHNICAL DEFINITIONAL AND AC- COUNTING MATTERS; THIRD, ON THE OVERRUN ISSUE, THE ONE IN WHICH WASTE IS GREATEST, WE WERE NOT ONLY ACCURATE, BUT NEW FIGURES RE- LEASED SINCE OUR SPEECH SHOW THAT THE AMOUNT OF WASTE HAS BEEN INCREASING THIS YEAR AT A CALAMITOUS PACE.

HOLBROOKE BELIEVES, AND I AGREE, THAT WE SHOULD CONTINUE TO PRESS THE DEFENSE FAT ISSUE. WE ARE ON STRONG GROUND. OUR CLAIM IS REASONABLE AND PLAUSIBLE. HOWEVER, ANY NUMBER CAN ALWAYS BE ATTACKED. OBVIOUSLY, ANY NUMBER WE USE WILL BE ATTACKED. HENCE, ANY NUMBERS WE USE SHOULD COME AS CITATIONS TO SOURCES. IN ADDITION, OUR EMPHASIS SHOULD BE THAT, WHILE DEFINITIONAL AND ACCOUNTING DIFFERENCES MAY PRODUCE DIFFERING ESTIMATES OF THE AMOUNT OF WASTE, NO ONE SERIOUSLY DISPUTES THE FACT THAT THERE IS CONSIDERABLE WASTE, WHICH TOUGH MANAGEMENT CAN REDUCE.

## I. THE AMERICAN LEGION LANGUAGE

IN CASE YOU DO NOT HAVE ON HAND A COPY OF THE LEGION SPEECH, HERE ARE THE RELEVANT PARAGRAPHS:

QUOTE WE MUST RECOGNIZE THAT OUR MILITARY PERSONNEL ARE TRANSFERRED TOO MUCH. AT ANY GIVEN MOMENT, ABOUT ONE OUT OF SEVEN OF THOSE PERSONNEL IS IN THE PROCESS OF MOVING, OR AWAY FROM THEIR FAMILY ON TEMPORARY TRAINING DUTY. THIS YEAR \$2.5 BILLION WILL GO SIMPLY TO MOVE SERVICE PERSONNEL, THEIR FAMILIES, TELEVISION SETS AND FURNITURE FROM ONE BASE TO ANOTHER. SUCH FREQUENT MOVES NOT ONLY EAT UP MONEY, THEY UNDERMINE MORALE. IF WE EXTEND THE AVERAGE TOUR OF DUTY BY JUST TWO MONTHS, WE COULD SAVE \$400 MILLION PER YEAR.

WE NEED TO REEXAMINE OUR MILITARY TRAINING PROGRAMS. RECENT CONGRESSIONAL HEARINGS, BY THE WAY, REVEALED THAT WE NOW HAVE AN AVERAGE OF ONE AND A HALF MILITARY STUDENTS FOR EACH INSTRUCTOR. BY MOVING TO A RATIO OF ONLY THREE STUDENTS TO EACH INSTRUCTOR, WE COULD SAVE AN ESTIMATED \$1 BILLION PER YEAR.

COST OVERRUNS HAVE BECOME CHRONIC. THE PENTAGON ITSELF ESTIMATES THAT THE TOTAL CURRENT COST OF OVERRUNS ON THE 45 WEAPONS SYSTEMS NOW IN THE PROCESS OF DE- VELOPMENT IN THE THREE SERVICES -- EXCLUSIVE OF IN- FLATION -- IS \$10.7 BILLION. OVER THE NEXT FIVE YEARS THAT WOULD APPROXIMATE THE COST OF THE PROPOSED B-1 BOMBER PROGRAM OVER THE SAME PERIOD. END QUOTE.

## II. EVANS & NOVAK

THE OFFENDING EVANS & NOVAK PARAGRAPH IS AS FOLLOWS:

QUOTE THE STAFF WORK WAS OBVIOUSLY HURRIED. AN EXTRA TWO MONTHS ON DUTY TOURS, THE PRINCIPLE OF WHICH IS INCLUDED IN CURRENT PENTAGON REFORMS, WOULD SAVE NOT \$400 MILLION BUT \$180 MILLION. THE PRESENT TEACHER-PUPIL RATIO IS NOT 1.5 TO 1 BUT 5 TO 1. TOTAL COST OVERRUNS ON 45 WEAPONS SYSTEMS NOW BEING DEVELOPED ARE \$13.4 BILLION NOT \$10.7 BILLION. END QUOTE.

### III. ANALYSIS

#### A. "DUTY TOURS"

WE SAID THE ANNUAL SAVINGS FROM EXTENDING TOURS OF DUTY AN ADDITIONAL TWO MONTHS WOULD BE \$400 MILLION. EVANS AND NOVAK (AND PRESUMABLY THE PENTAGON) SAY THE CORRECT FIGURE IS (ONLY) \$180 MILLION. BROOKINGS, IN THE PERSON OF MARTIN BINKEN AND TO WHOM HE REFERRED ME, NOW SAYS THE CORRECT FIGURE IS \$350 MILLION. ASPIN HAS OFFERED AN ANALYSIS WHICH WOULD SUPPORT THE ORIGINAL \$400 MILLION FIGURE. BUT BROOKINGS (BINKEN) WILL NOT GO ALONG WITH THAT. HENCE, IF PRESSED TO SPECIFY A FIGURE EVEN THOUGH IT MAY BE TEMPTING TO GO ALONG WITH AN ANALYSIS (ASPIN'S) WHICH WOULD PERMIT US TO SAY WE WERE COMPLETELY RIGHT, IT WOULD SEEM BEST NOT TO, SINCE BOTH BROOKINGS AND THE PENTAGON MIGHT SAY WE WERE TOO HIGH.

HERE IS THE UNDERLYING ANALYSIS.

BROOKINGS' ORIGINAL \$400 MILLION SUGGESTION TO US WAS BASED ON THE NUMBER OF MOVES REFLECTED IN THE BUDGET FOR FY '74. SINCE THEN, THE PENTAGON HAS INCREASED THE TIME BETWEEN MOVES TO 15 MONTHS. AT THIS LEVEL, THE AMOUNT OF SAVINGS REALIZABLE FROM A FURTHER TWO MONTHS EXTENSION OF THE TIME BETWEEN MOVES IS NOT AS GREAT AS IT WAS FOR FY '74--BROOKINGS' TOTAL, AS NOTED ABOVE, WOULD NOW BE \$350 MILLION.

OUR \$350 MILLION IS STILL A LONG WAY FROM THE EVANS AND NOVAK FIGURE OF \$180 MILLION. THE DIFFERENCE IS THIS: EVANS AND NOVAK (THE PENTAGON) HAVE EVIDENTLY COMPUTED ONLY THE SAVINGS IN DIRECT MOVING COSTS RESULTING FROM FEWER MOVES. BUT BROOKINGS (STRONGLY

SUPPORTED BY ASPIN) INCLUDE ALSO REDUCED MANPOWER COSTS, COVERING THE SALARIES OF PEOPLE IN TRANSIT.

TO QUANTIFY: TOTAL PERMANENT CHANGE OF STATION COSTS IN FY 77 INCLUDE AN ESTIMATED \$1.5-1.7 BILLION IN MOVING COSTS, PLUS \$1 BILLION IN SALARIES FOR PEOPLE IN TRANSIT (PENTAGON FIGURES). EXTENDING THE TIME BETWEEN MOVES FROM ITS PRESENT FIGURE OF 15 MONTHS TO 17 MONTHS IN EFFECT SAVES ABOUT 13% OF THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH MOVING. THIRTEEN PERCENT OF \$1.5-1.7 BILLION (MOVING COSTS ALONE) EQUALS \$195-220 MILLION (EVANS AND NOVAK'S PENTAGON FIGURE OF \$180 MILLION MUST COME FROM USING 12% AS THE PERCENTAGE REDUCTION INSTEAD OF 13%); THIRTEEN PERCENT OF \$1 BILLION (SALARIES) EQUALS \$130 MILLION. THE NET IS THAT BROOKINGS' FIGURE FOR TOTAL SAVINGS FROM A TWO MONTHS' EXTENSION WOULD BE \$330-\$350 MILLION. WE CAN STAND ON THAT.

FOR OUR PURPOSES, OF COURSE, THE MAIN POINT IS THAT EVERY SUBSTANTIAL SAVINGS COULD BE REALIZED BY AN EXTENSION OF THE TIME BETWEEN MOVES.

GOVERNOR CARTER HAS NEVER ENDORSED NEW EDUCATION PROGRAMS WHICH WOULD COST THE FEDERAL BUDGET \$30 BILLION, OR ANYTHING REMOTELY RESEMBLING SUCH AN OUTLANDISH FIGURE. THE DEMOCRATIC PLATFORM MAKES NO MENTION OF ANY DOLLAR FIGURE REGARDING FEDERAL EDUCATION EXPENDITURES.

2. A NUMBER OF TIMES DURING THE DEBATE, MR. FORD REPEATED THE THREADBARE REPUBLICAN CHARGE THAT THE DEMOCRATIC PLATFORM WOULD COST 100-\$200. THE CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE, WHICH SERVICES BOTH PARTIES IN CONGRESS, HAS ESTIMATED THAT THE DEMOCRATIC PLATFORM WOULD, IF FULLY IMPLEMENTED, COST \$40 BILLION,, AND THE REPUBLICAN PLATFORM WOULD COST \$50 BILLION. (NEEDS TO BE CHECKED.) MUCH OF THE COST OF THE REPUBLICAN PLATFORM WILL COME FROM



ADDITIONAL TAX EXPENDITURES IT PROPOSES, WHICH WILL  
PRIMARILY BENEFIT THE WEALTHY.

3. IN RESPONSE TO JAMES GANNON'S QUESTION ABOUT THE DRAIN ON THE TREASURY WHICH WOULD RESULT IF MR. FORD MEANT TO KEEP HIS TAX PROMISES, MR. FORD SAID THAT AN INCREASE IN PERSONAL EXEMPTIONS FROM \$750 PER PERSON TO \$1,000 PER PERSON "WOULD MEAN... THAT FOR A FAMILY OF FOUR THAT THE FAMILY WOULD HAVE \$1,000 MORE PERSONAL EXEMPTION--MONEY THAT THEY COULD SPEND FOR THEIR OWN PURPOSES...." MR. FORD SOUGHT TO LEAVE THE IMPRESSION THAT EACH FAMILY OF FOUR WOULD BE ABLE TO KEEP AN EXTRA \$1,000. IN FACT, THEY WOULD ONLY BE ABLE TO KEEP THE TAX THEY WOULD SPEND ON THEIR LAST \$1,000 OF INCOME. HE NEGLECTED TO POINT OUT THAT THIS PROPOSAL WOULD BENEFIT A FAMILY OF FOUR WHICH EARNS \$110,000 THREE AND ONE HALF TIMES AS MUCH AS A FAMILY OF FOUR WHICH EARNS \$8,000. (THE MARGINAL TAX RATE FOR THE LATTER FAMILY IS 19%.)

4. IN HIS COMMENTARY ON GOVERNOR CARTER'S RESPONSE TO JAMES GANNON'S QUESTION CONCERNING GOVERNOR CARTER'S REORGANIZATION PLAN, MR. FORD QUOTED GEORGIA'S CURRENT GOVERNOR BUSBEE AS SAYING THAT HE FOUND THE STATE'S MEDICAID PROGRAM "IN A SHAMBLES." BUT GOVERNOR BUSBEE WAS NOT DESCRIBING THE STATE OF THE GEORGIA PROGRAM AS HE FOUND IT, BUT THE NATIONAL PROGRAM--WHICH THE REPUBLICANS HAVE PERMITTED TO FALL INTO SUCH DISREPAIR. THAT AS MUCH AS \$7.5 BILLION A YEAR IS NOW BEING WASTED, THROUGH FRAUD and MISMANAGEMENT.

5. IN HIS COMMENTARY ON GOVERNOR CARTER'S RESPONSE TO ELIZABETH DREW'S QUESTION ABOUT TAX REFORM, MR. FORD CONTINUED TO REPEAT THE MISREPRESENTATION THAT GOVERNOR CARTER INTENDS TO RAISE THE TAXES PAID BY THE UPPER HALF OF AMERICAN FAMILIES, DESPITE THE FACT THAT THIS MISREPRESENTATION WAS BASED ON AN INACCURATE TRANSMISSION BY THE ASSOCIATED PRESS TO AN INTERVIEW WITH GOVERNOR CARTER--ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE A.P. TO BE INACCURATE, AS MR. FORD WELL KNOWS.

6. IN HIS COMMENTARY ON GOVERNOR CARTER'S RESPONSE TO JAMES GANNON'S QUESTION ON GOVERNOR CARTER'S REORGANIZATION PLANS, MR. FORD GROSSLY DISTORTED GOVERNOR CARTER'S RECORD OF REFORMING THE GOVERNMENT OF GEORGIA. MR. FORD STATED THAT STATE EXPENDITURES INCREASED UNDER GOVERNOR CARTER BY OVER 50%.

BUT TOTAL REVENUES ALSO INCREASED BY THAT AMOUNT, WITHOUT ANY INCREASE IN TAXES EXCEPT FOR THE EXCISE TAXES ON CIGARETTES AND GASOLINE,, AND EVEN THOSE WERE LESS THAN THE NATIONAL AVERAGE AFTER THE INCREASES. THE INCREASE IN REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES WAS DUE ALMOST ENTIRELY TO POPULATION GROWTH AND THE FACT THAT PERSONAL INCOME IN GEORGIA GREW OVER 25% DURING THE PERIOD JIMMY CARTER WAS GOVERNOR. (BETWEEN 1970 AND 1973, PERCAPITA PERSONAL INCOME ROSE FROM \$3,318 TO \$4,243 PER YEAR IN GEORGIA.) MOREOVER, EVERY YEAR JIMMY CARTER WAS GOVERNOR THERE WAS A BUDGET SURPLUS -- BY ABOUT \$116 MILLION WHEN HE LEFT OFFICE. 



SINCE JANUARY OF THIS YEAR, WE HAVE SEEN AT VARIOUS TIMES ROGERS MORTON ON THE WHITE HOUSE STAFF SERVING AS LIAISON WITH THE FORD CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE, RICHARD CHENEY, FORD'S CHIEF OF STAFF, CARRYING ON A NUMBER OF PURELY POLITICAL TASKS (ARM TWISTING UNCOMMITTED DELEGATES TO THE REPUBLICAN CONVENTION, SOLICITING GOVERNOR REAGAN'S SUPPORT), AND THE WHITE HOUSE STAFF, ALONG WITH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET AND THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS, PREPARING PAPERS AND MATERIALS FOR CAMPAIGN PURPOSES. OTHER EXAMPLES ABOUND--FEBRUARY TRIPS BY SECRETARY SIMON TO ALABAMA AND TEXAS FOR CAMPAIGN-RELATED FUNCTIONS (COST TO TAXPAYERS: \$7,023; COST TO FORD: \$201.16) AND THE RECENT PRINTING AT GOVERNMENT EXPENSE OF A 100-PAGE BOOK PRAISING FORD'S TWO YEARS ON OFFICE.

WHAT IS PARTICULARLY IRONIC ABOUT MR. FORD'S RECENT CAMPAIGNING IN ANN ARBOR AND THE ADVANCING BY WHITE HOUSE STAFFERS IS MR. FORD'S SPEECH THERE, IN WHICH HE STATES EMPHATICALLY: "IT IS NOT ENOUGH TO SAY 'TRUST ME.' TRUST MUST BE EARNED."

WITH THE TRAGIC DECLINE IN RECENT YEARS IN THE CONFIDENCE AND TRUST THE AMERICAN PEOPLE HAVE IN THEIR GOVERNMENT, IT IS EITHER A STRANGE FORM OF HUMOR OR EXTREMELY POOR JUDGMENT FOR THE CURRENT HEAD OF OUR GOVERNMENT TO ACT SO CAVALIERLY IN THE CONDUCT OF HIS CAMPAIGN FOR

- (A) YOU HAVE NEVER USED YOUR OFFICIAL POSITION AS GOVERNOR TO ESPOUSE YOUR RELIGIOUS BELIEFS AND NEVER WOULD.
- (B) AS GOVERNOR YOU BROUGHT INTO STATE GOVERNMENT PEOPLE HISTORICALLY BARRED FROM PARTICIPATION BY RACE AND RELIGION.
- (C) YOU RESPECT EVERY PERSON'S RIGHT TO HOLD HIS OWN RELIGIOUS BELIEFS AND TO PRACTICE THOSE BELIEFS IN THE WAY HE SEES FIT. NO ONE'S RELIGION IS BETTER THAN ANOTHER'S. EACH CAN SPEAK TO THEIR GOD IN THEIR OWN WAY.
- (D) THERE ARE THOSE WHO SAY THAT A SOUTHERN BAPTIST IS SO DIFFERENT THAT HE SHOULDN'T BE PRESIDENT. THEY SAID THAT ABOUT AN IRISH CATHOLIC FROM MASSACHUSETTS SIXTEEN YEARS AGO. THEY WERE WRONG THEN, AND WITH YOUR HELP, THEY'LL BE WRONG AGAIN. WE SOUTHERNERS ARE BEEN VICTIMS OF DISCRIMINATION--WHITE AND BLACK--AND WE KNOW HOW IT FEELS. I'LL TELL YOU THAT ETHNIC AMERICANS WILL GET A FAIR SHAKE IF I'M ELECTED.
- (E) GEORGIA HAS SUPPORTED CANDIDATES REGARDLESS OF RELIGION--AL SMITH IN 1928; JFK IN 1960 GOT HIS BIGGEST MAJORITY IN GEORGIA--BIGGER THAN IN MASSACHUSETTS.

2. A DIRECT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT THAT DISCRIMINATION HISTORICALLY EXISTED AND CONTINUES TO EXIST AGAINST ITALIAN-AMERICANS, IRISH-AMERICANS, POLISH-AMERICANS, AND OTHER SOUTHERN AND EASTERN EUROPEAN-ORIGIN AMERICANS.

- (A) IT IS WITHIN THE MEMORY OF ALL IN THIS ROOM, WHEN SIGNS SAYING ITALIANS, OR IRISH OR POLES OR JEWS NEED NOT APPLY.
- (B) WHILE THOSE SIGNS DO NOT EXIST TODAY, THE VESTIGES REMAIN AND DISCRIMINATION STILL EXISTS (THEY FEEL STRONGLY ABOUT THIS AND BELIEVE WE THINK ONLY BLACKS ARE THE VICTIMS OF DISCRIMINATION). THE PEOPLE IN THIS ROOM HAVE SUCCEEDED IN SPITE OF THIS DISCRIMINATION.

I THINK I HAVE SUCCEEDED ADMIRABLY ON THE LAST POINT. AGAIN, ALTHOUGH YOU ~~MAY WANT TO~~ SHOW THIS TO GOVERNOR CARTER WE DO NOT WANT TO RAISE THIS AGAIN UNLESS PRESSED.

~~WE ARE LOOKING INTO THE POSSIBILITY OF A SPEECH ON PRIVACY, AS A MEANS OF COUNTERING THE NEGATIVE IMPACT ON THE CIVIL LIBERTIES COMMUNITY.~~

QUESTION: GOVERNOR CARTER, COULD YOU ELABORATE ON THE VIEWS YOU EXPRESSED MONDAY IN OKLAHOMA CITY ON THE BURGER COURT'S RULINGS ON QUESTIONS OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE?

ANSWER: FIRST OF ALL, LET ME SAY THAT I AM NOT A LAWYER, SO I AM NOT AS FAMILIAR WITH THE LEGAL REASONING THAT LED TO SOME OF THESE DECISIONS AS I AM WITH THE REACTION TO THEM FROM LAWYERS, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS, AND ORDINARY CITIZENS AROUND THE COUNTRY. AS I UNDERSTAND IT, THE REAL ISSUE IS WHAT HAPPENS WHEN EVIDENCE IS ILLEGALLY OBTAINED, EITHER BECAUSE THE POLICE HAVE SEARCHED WITHOUT A PROPER LEGAL BASIS OR TAKEN A STATEMENT FROM A SUSPECT WITHOUT GIVING HIM THE PROPER WARNINGS ABOUT HIS RIGHTS. THE RULES IMPOSED BY MAPP V. OHIO AND MIRANDA V. ARIZONA REQUIRE THE EXCLUSION OF THE EVIDENCE OBTAINED IN THE WAY. *Chris*

THE OBJECTIVE OF THE WARREN COURT IN REQUIRING THIS EXCLUSION WAS TO CONTROL THE ILLEGAL ACTIONS OF THE POLICE, AND AS WE KNOW FROM THE REVELATIONS OF THE LAST SEVERAL YEARS ABOUT THE FBI AND THE CIA, THIS MATTER IS INDEED ONE OF CRITICAL IMPORTANCE. MANY COMMENTATORS, HOWEVER, HAVE QUESTIONED WHETHER THE EXCLUSION OF EVIDENCE IS THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAY TO ACHIEVE THIS PURPOSE. IT IMPOSES NO IMMEDIATE BURDEN ON THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AND IT HAS NO EFFECT WHATEVER IF THE POLICE OBJECTIVE IS SIMPLE SURVEILLANCE OF CONFISCATION OF CONTRABAND DRUGS OR WEAPONS. MOREOVER, IT PROVIDES NO REMEDY FOR THE INNOCENT VICTIMS OF ILLEGAL LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES. YET IT ALLOWS THE POTENTIALLY GUILTY PERSON WHOSE RIGHTS ARE VIOLATED TO BE RELEASED FROM CONVICTION AND PUNISHMENT IF THERE IS NO OTHER PERSUASIVE EVIDENCE OF GUILT.

THESE OBJECTIONS CERTAINLY DO NOT MEAN THAT THE EXCLUSIONARY RULES SHOULD BE ABANDONED COMPLETELY. EVERY MAJOR SOCIAL ADVANCE BEGINS WITH MANY ROUGH EDGES THAT UNDERGO A PROCESS OF REFINEMENT ONCE THE NEW POLICY IS FIRMLY IN PLACE AND ITS IMPACT CAN BE EVALUATED IN PRACTICE. THE EXCLUSIONARY RULES ARE NO EXCEPTION. I SUPPORT THIS PROCESS OF REFINEMENT SO LONG AS IT DOES NOT VIOLATE BASIC CIVIL LIBERTIES. THUS THE COURT HAS HELD THAT AN ILLEGALLY OBTAINED CONFESSION MAY BE USED BY THE PROSECUTOR

TO CAST DOUBT ON SUBSEQUENT CONFLICTING TESTIMONY BY THE DEFENDANT AT TRIAL (HARRIS V. NEW YORK, 1971), THAT AN ACCUSED MAY NOT SUPPRESS EVIDENCE OBTAINED BY AN ILLEGAL SEARCH OF SOMEONE ELSE'S PROPERTY (BROWN V. UNITED STATES, 1973), AND THAT FALSE TESTIMONY BEFORE A GRAND JURY CAN BE THE BASIS FOR A CONVICTION EVEN THOUGH FULL MIRANDA WARNINGS WERE NOT GIVEN BEFORE THE TESTIMONY WAS TAKEN (UNITED STATES V. MANDUJANO, 1976).

SOME OF THESE DECISIONS WERE CONROVERSIAL, WHILE OTHERS WERE GENERALLY ACCEPTED, BOTH ON AND OFF THE COURT. AND JUSTICES WHO WERE A PART OF THE WARREN COURT HAVE SUPPORTED SOME OF THESE DECISIONS. SO THE QUESTION IS NOT SIMPLY ONE OF CIVIL LIBERTIES AGAINST CRIME CONTROL. THERE ARE MANY STEPS THAT SHOULD BE TAKEN TO ASSURE THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES BEHAVE PROPERLY THAT WILL NOT RESULT IN FREEING THE GUILTY BECAUSE OF THEIR IMPROPER BEHAVIOR:

(1) PROVISION OF CIVIL REMEDIES FOR THE VICTIMS OF POLICE MISCONDUCT, WHICH THE SUPREME COURT HAS RECENTLY HELD TO BE IMPLICIT IN THE FOURTH AMENDMENT. (BIVENS V. SIX UNKNOWN NAMED AGENTS, 1971; BLACK, BLACKMUN, AND BURGER DISSENTING.)

(2) ESTABLISHMENT OF CLEAR LEGISLATIVE GUIDELINES AND JUDICIAL MECHANISMS THAT WILL ASSURE THAT THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES KNOW WHAT THE LAW IS AND CAN COMPLY WITH IT WITHOUT HAMPERING EXPEDITIOUS LAW ENFORCEMENT.

(3) TOUGH, COMPETENT MANAGEMENT TO ASSURE THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES ARE PROPERLY SUPERVISED, KNOW WHAT THEIR OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS ARE, AND HELD ACCOUNTABLE BY THEIR LOCAL SUPERVISORS FOR INFRACTIONS OF THESE RULES.

(4) REFORM OF TRIAL AND SENTENCING PROCEDURES TO ASSURE THAT THE MOST DANGEROUS CRIMINALS AND MULTIPLE OFFENDERS GET TOP PRIORITY IN PROSECUTION AND PUNISHMENT.

IF THESE PRINCIPLES ARE ADOPTED AND INSISTED UPON BY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AT ALL LEVELS, WE WILL BE ABLE TO ACHIEVE THE PROTECTION OF CIVIL LIBERTIES WITHOUT DEPRIVING SOCIETY OF THE ABILITY TO PUNISH CRIMINALS.

ROMAN CATHOLIC LEADERS DISCUSSED ABORTION FRIDAY WITH PRESIDENT FORD AND DECLARED THEY WERE ENCOURAGED BY HIS VIEWS. TEN DAYS AGO, THE SAME CLERGYMEN CAME AWAY 'DISAPPOINTED' FROM A MEETING WITH DEMOCRAT JIMMY CARTER.

CARTER'S OPPOSITION TO ANY CONSTITUTIONAL PROHIBITION ON ABORTION HAS PRODUCED DEMONSTRATIONS AT MANY OF HIS STOPS DURING THE FIRST WEEK OF THE FALL CAMPAIGN, PUSHING THE ISSUE TO PROMINENCE.

FORD, WHO WON'T MAKE HIS FIRST OUT-OF-TOWN TRIP UNTIL NEXT WEDNESDAY, SHARES CARTER'S OBJECTIONS TO AN AMENDMENT BANNING ABORTIONS. BUT FORD FAVORS AN AMENDMENT TO LET STATES LEGISLATE THE ISSUE FOR THEMSELVES. CARTER DOES NOT FAVOR SUCH AN AMENDMENT.

BUT CARTER HAS SAID HE RESPECTS THE RIGHTS OF OTHERS TO SEEK AN ANTI-ABORTION AMENDMENT.

AFTER THE CLERGYMEN TALKED WITH FORD FOR MORE THAN AN HOUR, ARCHBISHOP JOSEPH BERNARDIN TOLD REPORTERS: "WE ARE ENCOURAGED WITH THE PRESIDENT'S POSITION. THAT DOES NOT MEAN WE ARE TOTALLY SATISFIED." HE TERMED FORD'S ENDORSEMENT OF SOME KIND OF AMENDMENT A STEP IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION.

"WE DO FEEL, HOWEVER, THERE IS A BETTER APPROACH THAN THAT EMBODIED IN WHAT IS CALLED THE STATES' RIGHTS POSITION," SAID THE ARCHBISHOP.

HE SAID THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS, WHICH HE HEADS, WANTS AN AMENDMENT FOR "MAXIMUM PROTECTION OF THE UNBORN."

A CHANGE IN THE CONSTITUTION IS A WAY TO OVERRIDE A 1973 SUPREME COURT RULING THAT STATES CANNOT REGULATE ABORTIONS IN THE FIRST THREE MONTHS OF PREGNANCY. THE SAME DECISION PREVENTS STATES FROM PROHIBITING ABORTIONS EXCEPT IN THE LAST TRIMESTER.

FORD WAS THE ONLY MAJOR PARTY CANDIDATE NOT ON THE ROAD FRIDAY.

AS HE HEADED TO FLORIDA FROM THE MIDWEST, CARTER TERMED HIS INITIAL FORAYS AS "A GREAT WEEK." HE HAD SOUNDED THE NEED FOR UNITY AMONG DEMOCRATS AT A FACTORY GATE IN MILWAUKEE EARLY IN THE DAY AND PREDICTED A NEW THAT THE RACE AGAINST FORD WILL BE CLOSE.

THE DEMOCRATIC VICE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE, SEN. WALTER MONDALE, CRITICIZED FOREIGN POLICY FAILURES UNDER THE REPUBLICAN ADMINISTRATION AS "A MIRROR IMAGE OF THE LAWLESSNESS OF WATERGATE."

HIS REPUBLICAN COUNTERPART, SEN. BOB DOLE, WAS TELLING TEXANS IN DALLAS THAT CARTER WANTS TO BREAK UP U.S. OIL COMPANIES. CARTER HAS SAID HE FAVORS LIMITED DIVESTITURE OF THE PETROLEUM INDUSTRY, IN WHOLESALING AND RETAILING. TO GO BEYOND THAT, HE SAYS, WOULD BE COUNTER-PRODUCTIVE.

WITH THE FIRST OF THE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES' DEBATES LESS THAN TWO WEEKS AWAY, SEN. LOWELL WEICKER, R-CONN., CRITICIZED THE EXCLUSION OF MINOR PARTY CANDIDATES - AN EXCLUSION THAT MAY BE TESTED IN COURT.

WEICKER SAID IT IS A SAD COMMENTARY THAT THEY ARE NOT TO BE "AFFORDED THE SAME OPPORTUNITY TO PRESENT THEIR VIEWS TO THE NATION AS ARE PRESIDENT FORD AND MR. CARTER."

THE AMERICAN PARTY HAS FILED SUIT TO HALT THE DEBATES BECAUSE ITS PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE CAN'T TAKE PART. A HEARING HAS BEEN SCHEDULED IN U.S. DISTRICT COURT IN WASHINGTON NEXT FRIDAY.

THE DELEGATION AT THE WHITE HOUSE WAS HEADED BY ARCHBISHOP BERNARDIN AND TERENCE CARDINAL COOKE OF NEW YORK. IT INCLUDED TWO OTHER ARCHBISHOPS AND TWO BISHOPS.

AFTER THE SAME GROUP MET WITH CARTER, ARCHBISHOP BERNARDIN EXPRESSED DISAPPOINTMENT WITH HIS POSITION. CARTER SAID HE PERSONALLY OPPOSES ABORTION AND SPENDING FEDERAL MEDICAID FUNDS FOR TERMINATING PREGNANCY, BUT DOESN'T WANT THE CONSTITUTION CHANGED.

CARTER HAS ACKNOWLEDGED THAT "ABORTION IS A VERY SERIOUS PROBLEM FOR ME AS A CANDIDATE."

THE STATES RIGHT AMENDMENT, ARCHBISHOP BERNARDIN SAID, IS THOUGHT BY THE PRESIDENT TO BE "A LEGITIMATE INTERPRETATION OF THE REPUBLICAN PLATFORM."

MONDALE'S SPEECH AT SOUTH BEND, IND., WAS TOUTED BY AIDES AS A MAJOR EFFORT TO OUTLINE HIS PHILOSOPHY ON FOREIGN AFFAIRS. THE MINNESOTA SENATOR, HIS SPEECH WRITERS AND MEMBERS OF THE CARTER-MONDALE ISSUES AND POLICY STAFF WORKED ON THE SPEECH FOR A WEEK.

"WE STILL HAVE A GOVERNMENT THAT DOES NOT RECOGNIZE THAT POWER ALONE IS NOT ENOUGH; THAT PRINCIPLE MUST GOVERN OUR ACTIONS OVERSEAS," MONDALE SAID. "A GOVERNMENT THAT BELIEVES IN ITSELF HAS THE MOST ENDURING SECURITY OF ALL AND NO EXPEDIENCY WILL ACHIEVE SECURITY IF THAT SECURITY IS NOT BASED ON OUR OWN PRINCIPLES."

MONDALE ADDED THAT "NOTHING IS MORE DISTURBING THAN THE GAP BETWEEN THE GOODNESS OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE AND THE POLICIES BEING PURSUED IN WASHINGTON."

A CARTER ADMINISTRATION "WILL NOT INDISCRIMINATELY MAKE TANKS AND GUNS AVAILABLE TO EVERY COUNTRY WHICH SEEKS THEM," MONDALE SAID. "WE WILL NOT USE INTELLIGENCE AGENCIES TO TOPPLE FREELY ELECTED GOVERNMENTS."

DOLE, SPEAKING IN TEXAS WHICH GAVE ALL ITS REPUBLICAN CONVENTION VOTES TO RONALD REAGAN, SAID MORE AND MORE TEXAS REPUBLICANS NOW SUPPORT THE FORD-DOLE TICKET.

"I DON'T BELIEVE WE OUGHT TO BREAK UP THE OIL COMPANIES AS MR. CARTER DOES," DOLE SAID, APPARENTLY REFERRING TO CARTER'S SUPPORT FOR PARTIAL DIVESTITURE OF LARGE OIL COMPANIES.

"THE OIL INDUSTRY," SAID THE KANSAS SENATOR, "MEANS JOBS IN KANSAS AND JOBS IN TEXAS."

ROMAN CATHOLIC LEADERS, "DISAPPOINTED" WITH JIMMY CARTER'S ABORTION STAND; MET WITH PRESIDENT FORD TODAY AND SAID THEY WERE ENCOURAGED BY HIS VIEWS ON THAT ISSUE; CATAPULTED TO PROMINENCE IN THE PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN.

BUT ARCHBISHOP JOSEPH BERNARDIN SAID AFTER SPEAKING WITH FORD FOR MORE THAN AN HOUR "THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT WE ARE TOTALLY SATISFIED."

THE ARCHBISHOP HAD SAID AFTER A MEETING WITH CARTER TWO WEEKS AGO THAT HE AND OTHER CATHOLIC LEADERS WERE DISSATISFIED WITH THE DEMOCRATIC CANDIDATE'S OPPOSITION TO A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT FORBIDDING ABORTION.

FORD FAVORS A DIFFERENT KIND OF CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT - ONE THAT WOULD ALLOW STATES TO SET THEIR OWN POLICIES.

"WE FEEL THAT THERE ARE BETTER APPROACHES," SAID THE ARCHBISHOP. BUT HE SAID THE LEADERS WERE ENCOURAGED; ADDING THE BISHOPS WANT TO AFFORD THE UNBORN THE "MAXIMUM PROTECTION POSSIBLE."

HE SAID THE PRINCIPAL DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE APPROACHES OF FORD AND CARTER WAS THE "UNWILLINGNESS" OF THE DEMOCRAT TO SUPPORT ANY KIND OF CHANGE IN THE CONSTITUTION.

WITH BOTH MEN OPPOSED TO AN AMENDMENT TOTALLY PROSCRIBING ABORTION; THE PRESIDENT'S TASK WAS TO PERSUADE THE CATHOLICS THAT HE IS MORE IN TUNE WITH THEIR VIEWS THAN CARTER. FROM ARCHBISHOP BERNARDIN'S COMMENTS; HE APPARENTLY SUCCEEDED.

THE ARCHBISHOP BEGAN THE MEETING WITH THE PRESIDENT BY READING A STATEMENT THAT "WE ADDRESS OURSELVES TO ISSUES ONLY. WE NEITHER ENDORSE NOR OPPOSE CANDIDATES OR PARTIES."

HE SAID THE GROUP; WHO WERE THE SAME PEOPLE WHO MET WITH CARTER; EXPRESSED "DEEP CONCERN OVER THE SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE IN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S FUNDING OF ABORTION IN RECENT YEARS."

HE REPORTED FORD INDICATED HE IS PERSONALLY OPPOSED TO SPENDING MEDICAID MONEY FOR THAT PURPOSE. CARTER; TOO; DOESN'T WANT GOVERNMENT FUNDS USED FOR ABORTIONS.

WHITE HOUSE PRESS SECRETARY RON NESSEN SAID THURSDAY THAT FORD IS IN FAVOR OF A LET-THE-STATES-DO-IT AMENDMENT.

WHITE HOUSE PRESS SECRETARY RON NESSEN SAID THURSDAY THAT FORD DOES NOT FAVOR A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT BANNING ABORTION BUT DOES FAVOR AN AMENDMENT LETTING EACH STATE SET ITS OWN POLICY ON ABORTIONS.

CARTER HAS REFUSED TO ENDORSE AN AMENDMENT BANNING ABORTION. HE SAID HE PERSONALLY OPPOSES ABORTION AND ANY USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO PAY FOR ABORTIONS. BUT HE HAS SAID HE RESPECTS THE RIGHTS OF ANYONE WHO SEEK PASSAGE OF AN ANTI-ABORTION AMENDMENT.

ARCHBISHOP JOSEPH BERNARDIN OF CINCINNATI, PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS, SAID THE 'PRINCIPAL DIFFERENCE' BETWEEN THE FORD AND CARTER POSITIONS IS THE 'UNWILLINGNESS' OF THE DEMOCRATIC NOMINEE TO SUPPORT ANY KIND OF CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE ARCHBISHOP SAID THAT 'WE FEEL THAT THERE ARE BETTER APPROACHES' THAN THE ONE FAVORED BY FORD.

THE CATHOLIC GROUP OPPOSES VIRTUALLY ALL KINDS OF ABORTION.

NOTING FORD'S APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT LETTING EACH STATE DECIDE ITS OWN ABORTION POLICY, THE ARCHBISHOP SAID THE GROUP'S POSITION IS TO AFFORD THE UNBORN THE 'MAXIMUM PROTECTION POSSIBLE.'

ARCHBISHOP BERNARDIN SAID THE CATHOLIC GROUP EXPRESSED TO FORD 'DEEP CONCERN OVER THE SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE IN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S FUNDING OF ABORTION IN RECENT YEARS.

THE GOVERNMENT PROVIDES THIS FUNDING THROUGH ITS HEALTH CARE PROGRAMS.

THE ARCHBISHOP SAID FORD 'INDICATED IT IS HIS PERSONAL POSITION THAT HE IS AGAINST GOVERNMENT FUNDING' AND THAT HE WILL UNDERTAKE A STUDY TO DETERMINE WHAT HE CAN DO TO DISCOURAGE IT.

FORD HAD NOT PREVIOUSLY EXPRESSED OPPOSITION TO FEDERAL PROGRAMS THAT FINANCE ABORTIONS.

DISCUSSING THE INCREASE IN FEDERAL OUTLAYS, ARCHBISHOP BERNARDIN SAID IT WAS NOT CLEAR TO THE BISHOPS HOW MUCH FORD 'IS PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THIS.'

AT THE OUTSET OF THE MEETING WITH FORD, THE ARCHBISHOP READ A STATEMENT SAYING: 'AS YOU KNOW, WE ADDRESS OURSELVES TO ISSUES ONLY. WE NEITHER ENDORSE NOR OPPOSE CANDIDATES OR PARTIES.'

IN ADDITION TO ARCHBISHOP BERNARDIN, THOSE MEETING WITH FORD WERE ARCHBISHOP JOHN CARBERRY OF ST. LOUIS, VICE PRESIDENT OF THE BISHOPS' COUNCIL; TERENCE CARDINAL COOKE OF NEW YORK CITY; ARCHBISHOP JOHN J. MCGUIRE OF NEW YORK; BISHOP JAMES W. MALONE OF YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO; AND BISHOP JAMES S. RAUSCH.

THEY DECLINED TO BE PHOTOGRAPHED WITH FORD.

THE CATHOLIC LEADERS ALSO HAD DECLINED TO BE PHOTOGRAPHED WITH CARTER DURING HIS MEETING WITH THEM HERE AUG. 31.

AFTER THAT MEETING, ARCHBISHOP BERNARDIN SAID OF CARTER'S STAND: 'PERSONAL OPPOSITION IS NOT ENOUGH.'

NEW YORK -- AN INQUIRY INTO MARITIME UNION CONTRIBUTIONS TO GERALD R. FORD CONGRESSIONAL CAMPAIGNS IN MICH., CONDUCTED WHILE LEON JAWORSKI WAS SPECIAL WATERGATE PROSECUTOR, TURNED UP NOTHING THAT "CALLED FOR FURTHER ACTION," JAWORSKI SAID TODAY.

"WE FOUND NO CONNECTION WITH WATERGATE," JAWORSKI TOLD REPORTERS.

JAWORSKI'S OBSERVATION CAME AMID REPORTS THE SPECIAL PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE HAS BEGUN A NEW INQUIRY INTO THE HANDLING OF THE UNIONS' POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS.

THE SPECIAL PROSECUTOR RECENTLY SUBPOENAED RECORDS OF TWO MARITIME UNION AND THREE GOP COMMITTEES IN MICH. MATERIAL JAWORSKI SAID HE HAD EXAMINED

CONTINUOUS INTERFERED @ MOODS BUSINESS FOR... INC.

HIMSELF WHILE SPECIAL PROSECUTOR.

PRES. FORD'S SPECIAL COUNSEL, PHILIP BUCHEN, COMPLAINED EARLIER ABOUT THE TIMING OF THE REPORTED NEW INQUIRY, WHICH COMES A LITTLE MORE THAN A MONTH BEFORE THE ELECTION.

1. GOVERNOR CARTER'S STATEMENT ON VETOES SHOULD BE AMENDED TO REFER TO "VETO OVERRIDES": FORD HAS HAD A HIGHER PERCENTAGE OF HIS VETOES OVERRIDDEN THAN ANY PRESIDENT SINCE ANDREW JOHNSON. FORD HAS VETOED 56 BILLS AND BEEN OVERRIDDEN 11 TIMES. BY CONTRAST, IN EIGHT YEARS, KENNEDY AND JOHNSON WERE NEVER OVERRIDDEN; AND EISENHOWER IN HIS EIGHT YEAR TERM, WAS OVERRIDDEN ONLY TWICE.

2. THE STATISTICS CITED BY FORD FOR TRUMAN AND ROOSEVELT VETOES ARE ACCURATE ONLY IF THE HUNDREDS OF PRIVATE BILLS THEY VETOED ARE INCLUDED. IF THEY ARE NOT, ROOSEVELT AVERAGED ONLY 13 VETOES OF PUBLIC BILLS A YEAR, TRUMAN 10 VETOES.

3. CARTER DID VETO 54 OF 3,580 BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS OVER A 4 YEAR PERIOD. NONE OF THESE VETOES DEALT WITH JOB CREATION, IMPROVED HEALTH CARE, GOVERNMENT SECRECY, IMPROVED HOUSING; RATHER THEY CONCERNED THE TYPICAL TYPE

OF PRIVATE BILL AND SPECIAL INTEREST LEGISLATION PASSED BY  
A STATE LEGISLATURE. EXAMPLES:

- (A) BILL TO CREATE A NEW POLITICAL JUDICIAL CIRCUIT.
- (B) BILL TO EXEMPT CERTAIN LENDERS FROM LOAN DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS.
