You will be riding on the chopper to today's bill signing with Senator Pell, Chairman, Subcommittee on Education, and Congressman Bill Ford, Chairman, Subcommittee on Post-secondary Education.

Senator Pell was very helpful on the Refugee Education Assistance Bill and attempted to help on the Youth Employment Bill.

Congressman Ford (whose wife, Martha will also be attending the bill signing) was elated with your trip to the Ford plant in his district. He was as effusive in his praise as he has been in the past in his dissatisfaction with Administration policy. You should share with him your disappointment that Unemployment Compensation did not receive final action. He worked very hard on it and will be ready to resume his work during the "lame duck" session.

Following your signing of the Higher Education bill you should call upon Senator Pell and Congressman Ford. Also attending will be: Senator Jennings Randolph, Congressman Mario Biaggi (D-NY), Congressman John Buchanan (R-Ala.), Congressman Joe Fisher (D-Va.) and Congressman Thomas Petri (R-Wisc.).
