I regret to inform you that I intend to leave the position of Administrator of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration on 20 January 1981.


It has been an honor and a pleasure to serve you and the country in this position, but I can no longer remain in public life in the face of the competitive opportunities available to me and to my family in private life. An opportunity has arisen which seems particularly suited to my interests, and I must take it.

I will be informing my colleagues within the Administration and the Congress of my plans; I will make it clear that my decision is motivated by personal considerations. I deeply appreciate the attention and support you have consistently offered to the country's civil aeronautics and space programs; I remain devoted to these same interests even though I will no longer serve them directly. I continue to believe that these programs can play an even greater role of service to the country and the world than they have before.

Should it be possible for me to be of further use to the country from my private capacity, I would be honored to do so.

Thank you for the opportunity to serve you and to serve our country.


