Q: WHAT IS YOUR ATTITUDE TOWARDS THE IRANIAN-IRAQI WAR?  
HOW DO YOU THINK IT SHOULD BE SETTLED?

A: WE BELIEVE THERE SHOULD BE AN END TO THE HOSTILITIES  
BETWEEN IRAQ AND IRAN AND THE IMMEDIATE COMMENCEMENT OF  
NEGOTIATIONS TO SETTLE DISPUTED BOUNDARIES. THIS REFLECTS  
THE LONG-STANDING POLICY OF THE U.S. THAT ALL TERRITORIAL  
DISPUTES SHOULD BE SETTLED PEACEFULLY AND NOT BY AGGRESSION.

THE U.S. REMAINS COMMITTED TO THE PROPOSITION THAT THE  
NATIONAL INTEGRITY OF IRAN IS IN THE INTEREST OF REGIONAL  
STABILITY. WE ARE OPPOSED TO IRAN'S DISMEMBERMENT.

WE WILL SUPPORT THE UN AND THE ISLAMIC CONFERENCE IN  
THEIR EFFORTS TO TERMINATE THE CONFLICT AND TO RESOLVE  
THE DISPUTE PEACEFULLY. WE URGE ALL NATIONS TO SUPPORT  
THESE EFFORTS AND NOT TO WIDEN THE CONFLICT.

IT IS ESSENTIAL FOR THE PEACE OF THE REGION, AS WELL  
AS FOR THE WELL-BEING OF THE TWO WARRING NATIONS, THAT  
THE CONFLICT BE TERMINATED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. A PROLONGED





SUBJECT: Significant Actions, Secretary and Deputy Secretary of Defense (October 4-10, 1980)

Military Readiness: The press reports on my readiness speech in El Paso yesterday were reasonably balanced, and helped put this very important issue into a more reasonable and accurate context. What is demonstrably not accurate is Richard Allen's press statement of this afternoon, which suggests that I ordered the military to change the readiness system to emphasize the positive. In fact, the readiness reporting system has been toughened during the past three years. (U)

AWACS Support for Saudi Arabia: We continue to fly two or three E-3A AWACS sorties a day in support of the Saudi Arabian air defense systems. A data link has been established between AWACS and the U.S. Middle East/Indian Ocean Naval Task Force. Training intercepts have been conducted with Royal Saudi Air Force fighters. In order to support the 24-hour operation expected by the Saudis, we are deploying two KC-135 tankers to Riyadh at Saudi request. In the next week or so I'll get a tape showing a sample of what the E-3A sees.- (S)

Assignment of Cruiser to the Middle East Naval Force: To enhance the air defense posture in the Persian Gulf, yesterday I directed that a cruiser from the Pacific fleet be deployed to replace a destroyer now assigned to the Middle East Force. The cruiser will transmit air defense data to supplement AWACS coverage and provide information when AWACS is not available. It will also improve our ability to respond in the unlikely event of operations against our vessels near the Gulf. (S)

Nuclear Weapons Disclosure Policy: In response to Congressional and media inquiries concerning the Titan II missile incident, I have decided to issue a new DoD directive clearly reaffirming our policy not to confirm or deny the presence of nuclear weapons. The directive, however, will provide for an exception to this policy when an accident occurs in which there is a high probability of public alarm. Such exceptions will be granted only after a determination that national security will not be impaired by the disclosure of nuclear weapon location. This policy clarification was announced in Little Rock today by the Secretary of the Air Force. (U)

Security Assistance to Turkey: Graham met late last week with Turkish Deputy Prime Minister Ozal to review a broad range of security assistance issues. Ozal asked for \$400 million in Foreign Military Sales credits for FY82, price reductions on U.S. military equipment, F-4 aircraft, and our agreement to allow Turkey to liquidate its \$50.7 million trust fund shortfall over a five-year period. Graham agreed with Ozal's analysis of Turkey's strategic importance, but pointed out the economic realities of U.S. budgetary and legal restrictions. We will continue to work with State to resolve these issues.





Boston Meeting With Senior Citizens

I can remember when it was a rather rare thing for people to live past their early 70s. Thanks to better medical care and our growing knowledge of how to keep older people healthy and active, this will be the fastest growing age group in the 1980s. Demographers and economists are writing about the problems of an aging America. To me, this is not a problem, but an opportunity of enormous potential, not only for the individuals involved, but for the Nation.

If I may just speak personally for a moment, my Mother is 82 now. She just broke her hip and that has slowed her down temporarily. Not everyone joins the Peace Corps at 68 and goes off to India. But Mother is typical in many ways of millions of older Americans who continue to serve long

past the age when they once would have been consigned to idleness. Like Mother, they use their later years to take up new interests, to do things they always wanted to do or try out things they had not dreamed of doing in their youth.

I should add that even before my Mother's accident, I had been encouraging the National Institute on Aging to work on research aimed at this particular problem, which is one that affects hundreds of thousands of older Americans.

Senator Kennedy's Mother has been ill recently as well, but she has also used these years to work constructively in important causes. Her life has been a source of great inspiration to the whole country. At a time when many Americans long for a sense of stability, for strong [family] values and deep religious faith, for examples of lives lived bravely and with concern for others, Rose Kennedy is a symbol of courage and grace and dignity that sustains us all.

President John F. Kennedy said in a message to Congress on older Americans: "It is not enough for a great nation merely to have added new years to life -- our objective must also be to add new life to those years."

That is still our objective. 55

The precious gift of time is increasingly within the grasp of Americans, but we must make sure that it is a blessing, an expansion of potential, not a painful burden stripped of dignity and all that makes life sweet. This will be one of the crucial challenges of the 1980s. We must make these added years for our people a time of rich fulfillment that will benefit Americans of every age. 56

Social Security is the cornerstone of a decent life for older Americans. Four years ago it was on the brink of bankruptcy. I promised that if I was elected President I would protect and strengthen the Social Security system.

*after a long and difficult political fight in the Congress.*

I kept that pledge. We averted the system's collapse, and we did more as well. We eliminated restrictions that caused retired people to have their benefits cut if they remarried. We increased the <sup>earnings</sup> retirement test limitation for retired workers from \$3,200 to \$5,000. We raised benefits to keep up with the cost of living.

The Democratic Congress and I also raised the mandatory retirement age to 70 so that older Americans can remain productive and the choice of when to retire can be theirs.

As long as I am President, I will continue to work to strengthen the Social Security system, so that it will meet the changing needs of Americans as they become older and retire.

Thank you, Bob. When you have a man of proven integrity like (former auditor general) Bob Casey with you, you are way ahead of the game.

Congressman [Rafael] Musto, Mayor [Eugene] Hickey [of Scranton], Mayor [Robert] Loftus [of Pittston], ladies and gentlemen:

Ray Musto must have set a record as a Congressman who gets things done and does not waste any time doing it. He was sworn in one day, and the next day he was announcing a \$1.2 million grant from the Economic Development Administration.

I just came from a big Democratic rally in Boston with Senator Ted Kennedy. Being in Boston with Ted Kennedy is a lot like being in Veterans Stadium with Pete Rose. When you are going into the home stretch, they are the kind of people you want on your team.

Boston. Two prominent small business leaders after a private meeting with President Carter at Pier 4 Restaurant in Boston, endorsed the President's bid for re-election, saying he "he has shown more concern for the future of small enterprise than any President in the nation's history".

Meeting with Mr. Carter on Wednesday, October 15, were Frank C. Romano, Jr., President of Agawam Associates in Rowley, Massachusetts and David A. Tonneson of Tonneson, Mela, Curtin & Co., Wakefield, Massachusetts. Both contend that their endorsement reflects the majority of the nation's 13 million small companies which employ 53% of the work force and generates 43% of the Gross National Product.

The two executives are directors of the Smaller Business Association of New England (SBANE), Waltham, Massachusetts, the nation's oldest small business association. Tonneson is the Chairman of the SBANE Tax Committee. SBANE, although legislatively active does not endorse political candidates.

The President deserves the support of small enterprise, said Romano and Tonneson, largely due to his initiation of the historic White House Conference on Small Business. The Conference began in Boston in August, 1978 on the strength of SBANE, met in 57 different sites around the nation and concluded with a four day session in Washington last January. Tonneson and Romano were delegates to the Conference.

Emerging from the Conference was a series of proposals that forms the legislative blueprint for small business in the 1980's. Among the 12 issue areas covered were Taxation, Government Regulation, Women and Minorities in Business, International Trade, and Innovation, all relating to small business.

One of the Conference proposals and measured to limit the regulatory burden on small business was passed by Congress

and signed by President Carter on September 19. A second Conference proposal -- that reimburses court and attorney fees to small companies who win civil cases brought by Government was passed by Congress and awaits the President's signature. The New England executives asked the President to sign the bill without delay.

SUBJECT: Appointments to ICSID Panels

You have the opportunity to appoint four panelists each to the Panel of Conciliators and the Panel of Arbitrators of the International Centre for the Settlement of Investment Disputes (ICSID). No Senate confirmation is required.

ICSID is a World Bank affiliate which helps to promote a stable framework for international investment by providing facilities for the arbitration and conciliation of investment disputes between foreign investors and host governments. Every Administration since ICSID's establishment in 1966 has strongly supported ICSID, recognizing that it provides orderly mechanisms for settling investment disputes that might otherwise severely strain bilateral political relations. ICSID now has 78 members, including more than 50 developing countries; investors and host governments increasingly agree to settle disputes under ICSID's auspices; and ICSID, still a relatively young institution, is gradually gaining a considerable measure of respect among both developed and developing countries.

The present incumbents were appointed in 1974 and their terms expired on August 2, 1980. They were widely criticized as not being sufficiently qualified in the field of international law and investment.

Treasury, State and I recommend eight highly qualified persons (see attached list). The White House Personnel Office has approved them and all of them have told me they would be delighted to serve.
