The authorizing statutes designate the Commissioner, Public Building Services of GSA, as a member of the Council. Duffey's memo recommends that Jay Solomon, the Administrator of GSA, be appointed.

We called Duffey's office to clarify whether Solomon's appointment was in lieu of the Commissioner, or a new addition to the Council. (The statute authorizes the President to make changes as deemed necessary).

It is not clear what the intention is, and Duffey's office asked that we hold the memo at this time.
