The American Association for the Advancement of Science, the largest mass organization of scientists in the country, will be meeting in Washington from February 12-18. The AAAS has over 115,000 members and 280 affiliated societies which enable it to reach a universe of over 5 million people. Some 5,000 people will attend the Washington meeting.

You have been invited to address the meeting. By and large, the AAAS membership is supportive of your views on energy, non-proliferation, SALT, the comprehensive test ban, the Clinch River Breeder, the Panama Canal, the increasing aid for developing countries. A Presidential appearance could serve to activate a large, intelligent, vocal, and influential segment of the population on behalf of these Presidential initiatives.

The AAAS will be warmly responsive to your FY 79 budget with its strong initiative in basic research.

Bob Lipschutz, Jack Watson, Peter Bourne and Frank Press recommend. Zbig Brzezinski is favorably inclined, depending on the President's calendar.
