MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: Reappointment of Mr. George Ives to the
National Mediation Board

I wish to recommend that you reappoint Mr. George Ives to membership on the National Mediation Board (NMB) when his present term expires June 30, 1978. By statute, the composition of the NMB may not include more than two members of the same political party. Mr. Ives occupies the Republican seat. He has been a member of the NMB since 1969 and during that time has gained the confidence and respect of airline and railroad labor and management. He has been supported by these parties in each of his prior reappointments. We have discussed this particular reappointment with the parties and they again enthusiastically endorse it.

The National Mediation Board has been extremely cooperative with the Department of Labor under this Administration, keeping us fully informed of dispute developments. George Ives, as chairman during the past year, has communicated with us regularly. In that regard, it should be noted that the Railway Labor Act provides that the Board members shall select their own chairman. Since its inception, the Board has made a practice of rotating the chairmanship among the three members. George has been the chairman during the past year. Dave Stowe is scheduled to become chairman on July 1, 1978.
