The President met with the Justices of the Supreme Court at the White House on the opening day of their session last year. It was the first time the traditional meeting had taken place since the 1950's.

We received a letter from the Chief Justice this year officially notifying the President that the Supreme Court was beginning its session. They did not request a meeting, as they did last year. We inquired with the Clerk of the Court as to whether we should have another meeting with the Justices this year. They suggested that, because of the timetable, it not be held.

We may want to do it again next year and we will plan ahead for it, or we may want to hold it at the end of this session.
