In honor of Womens History Month the Jimmy Carter Library and Museum is pleased to feature one of Georgia's outstanding contemporary women, the 21st President of Young Harris College, Cathy Cox. President Cox is an honors graduate of the Walter F. George School of Law at Mercer University and served as Georgia's Secretary of State from 1999-2007. Prior to that position she served as Assistant Secretary of State and was a member of the Georgia House of Representatives. President Cox was an attorney with law firms in Atlanta and Bainbridge, her hometown, and also worked as a reporter with newspapers in Bainbridge and Gainesville, Georgia. She has been instrumental in the development of growing Young Harris College from a 2-year to a 4-year institution since her presidency in 2007.
