William J. vanden Heuvel was born April 14, 1930, in Rochester, New York. He served as co-chairperson of the New York Citizens' Committee for Jimmy Carter during the 1976 presidential campaign. He received his B.A. from Cornell University in 1950 and his LL.D. in 1952, and was admitted to the New York Bar in the same year. He also served in the following capacities: Executive Assistant to the Ambassador of Thailand, 1953-1954; Special Counsel to the Governor of New York, 1958; Associate with Javits, Moore and Turbin, 1959-1961; Special Assistant to the Attorney General of the United States, 1962-1964; Chairman of the New York City Board of Corrections, 1970-1973; United States Ambassador to the European Office, United Nations, Geneva, 1977-1979; and United States Ambassador, Deputy/Permanent Representative to the United Nations, 1979-1981.
