“Freedom’s Sisters” Family Weekend at the Carter Presidential Library *Historical Performances, Frank & Wanda, Church Discount, Prize Drawings*

Atlanta, GA. – The Jimmy Carter Presidential Library & Museum celebrates its new exhibition “Freedom’s Sisters” with an exciting “Family Weekend,” August 20, 21 and 22.

“Freedom’s Sisters” is a compelling new interactive exhibition of twenty extraordinary women and their contributions to the struggle for equality and justice in America. Through their courageous actions, they changed the course of history. By defying their circumstances, they became American heroes.

The celebration begins Friday morning (August 20th) as V103’s “Frank and Wanda” broadcasts live from the Carter Museum lobby from 6:00am until 10:00 am. Sunday is also “Church Program Discount Day” at the Carter Presidential Museum. Bring your program or bulletin from religious services the weekend of August 21st/22nd and get \$2 off our normal \$8 adult admission.
