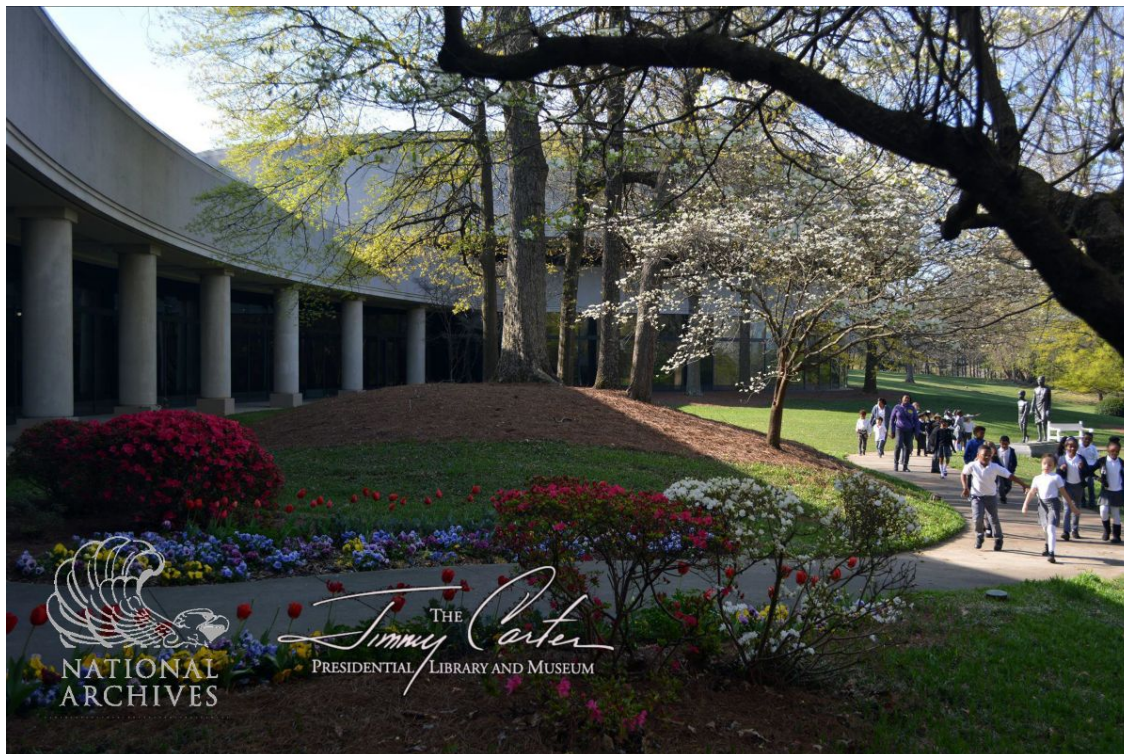

### National Archives Research Rooms and Presidential Libraries Nationwide to Close March 14

WASHINGTON, March 13, 2020 –As a public health precaution, due to COVID-19, the following changes are effective close of business Friday, March 13:

**All National Archives research rooms nationwide, including those at Presidential Libraries, will be closed to the public until further notice.**

**All museums, including those at Presidential Libraries, will be closed to the public until further notice.**

**All public events in National Archives facilities nationwide are cancelled until further notice.** This includes in-person public programs, tours, school group visits, public meetings, external conferences, and facility rentals. Where possible, we will
